QUESTIONS/CLARIFICATIONS:

1. Question: What is the Engineers estimate or budget for this project?

Answer: Budget is \$125,000.00

2. Question: Is a General Contractors license a requirement for this project? Florida passed a new law that no longer requires a General Contractors license to do commercial painting in Florida.

Answer: Yes, despite the change in Florida law concerning the licensing requirements for commercial painting, it is our opinion that the specialized requirements and broader scope of this specific project necessitate the involvement of a licensed General Contractor. This ensures both compliance with various regulations and the highest standards of quality and safety for the project. Please see supporting clarification below:

- A. Scope of Work: While the main task is tank wall cleaning, the project involves more than just surface treatment. If there's damage to the walls of the water tank discovered post-cleaning, repairs are essential. Repairs of such nature are generally beyond the purview of a commercial painting contractor and require the expertise of a General Contractor with a background in structural repairs.
- B. Confined Space Work: Working in a confined space such as the inside of a water tank presents unique safety and environmental challenges. This includes issues with air quality, access, and egress, all of which require specialized training and equipment. The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) provides detailed regulations for working in confined spaces (29 CFR 1910.146), including mandatory training and use of specialized equipment, typically handled by a General Contractor.
- C. Quality and Compliance: The structural integrity and quality of work are non-negotiable for ensuring public safety. A General Contractor can ensure compliance with applicable laws, codes, and standards, including those by the American Water Works Association (AWWA) for water tanks.

- D. Project Management: A General Contractor would be better suited to manage the various subcontractors that might be involved in aspects like painting, repairs, and safety measures.

QUESTIONS/CLARIFICATIONS:

1. Page A-2, Section #2, Competency of Bidder refers to a form called "Information Required of Bidder". This is referring to page A-21, Bidder's General Information.

2. Q: Please clarify the qualifications required to perform this work.

A: The Reference Sheet requests information on three (3) governmental entities that received similar services in the past year. It is understood that "similar services" refer specifically to the rehabilitation of concrete ground storage tanks and that General Contractor experience and qualification will be taken into consideration.

3. Q: Please clarify if disinfection is part of the scope of work as it is not listed on the bid form.

A: After the contractor completes the work, the City will manage the disinfection material and process. Additionally, bacteriological sampling responsibilities will be undertaken by the City.

4. Q: Please clarify if sediment removal is part of the scope of work. If it is supposed to be removed, how much sediment will need to be removed?

A: Yes, it is necessary to remove sediment from the tank. Providing an exact estimate is challenging due to the tank's current operational status. The tank underwent an inspection in June 2022, during which sediment from the tank bottom was vacuumed (a copy of the report was provided in the technical specifications section of the Bid package). Regarding the build-up on the wall, it measures up to 1/4 inch and is unevenly distributed. Samples brought by the cleaning company were thin and resembled potato chips in shape.

5. Q: Please clarify if we are to provide unit pricing for the items noted in the project completion and documentation section of the revised scope of work document.

A: The bid package contains the bid prices schedule, and there is no additional price table provided.

6. Q: Will there be access to electric and water?

A: Yes, there will be access to both electric and water. The water is from a hose spigot.

7. Q: When can the work begin?

A: As soon as the Bid is awarded and a Notice to Proceed is issued. The City will need a two (2) day notice to empty the tank.

8. Contractors should plan on bringing their own bathroom.

9. Work hours are Monday thru Friday 7:00 am to 7:00 pm

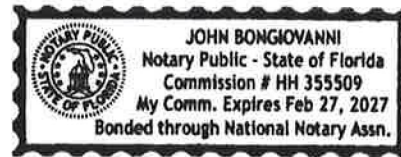
