A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SUPPORT AND COMMITMENT PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE SW 6TH STREET TRAFFIC CALMING AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR THE FUNDING ELIGIBILITY THROUGH THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) COMPLETE STREETS AND OTHER INITIATIVES LOCALIZED PROGRAM (CSLIP); PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) approved the Complete Streets and other Localized Initiatives Program (CSLIP) on July 9th, 2015;

Whereas, the SW 6<sup>th</sup> Street Traffic Calming and Pedestrian Improvements Project will be evaluated and ranked by the MPO, then vetted to determine programmability in accordance to the CSLIP policies;

Whereas, a resolution from the City of Margate City Commission stating support for the project is required to establish funding eligibility;

Whereas, federally funded projects off the state highway system are delivered using the federally mandated Local Agency Program (LAP) process;

Whereas, the City of Margate commits to administer and deliver the project under LAP;

Whereas, the LAP program is reimbursement based as specified in the LAP Agreement;

Whereas, the City of Margate commits to funding upfront costs for design, Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services, and construction to be then reimbursed as per the LAP agreement;

Whereas, the City of Margate commits to program funding for construction contingency per the requirements of LAP;

Whereas, the SW  $6^{\text{th}}$  Street Traffic Calming and Pedestrian Improvements project will be constructed within the agency's right of way;

Whereas, it is the responsibility of the City of Margate to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadways after the project's completion;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida, hereby demonstrates its full support and commitment to program funding for the NW 6th Street Traffic Calming and Pedestrian Improvements Project through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Complete Streets and other Localized Initiatives Program (CSLIP).

SECTION 2: The City of Margate seeks to obtain funding eligibility through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Complete Streets and other Localized Initiatives Program (CSLIP).

**SECTION 3:** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
