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CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 26 "PARKING NONCOMMERCIAL VEHICLES USED FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES," ARTICLE 1 GENERAL," SECTION 26 - 3REGULATIONS FOR NONCOMMERCIAL VEHICLES PURPOSES"; RECREATIONAL PROVIDING REGISTRATION; PROVIDING FOR BACK AND SIDE YARD PARKING; PROVIDING FOR EXCEPTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, CHAPTER 26 - "Parking of Noncommercial Vehicles Used For Recreational Purposes and Commercial Vehicles," Article 1 - "In General," Section 26-3 "Parking regulations for noncommercial vehicles used for recreational purposes," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 26-3. Parking regulations for noncommercial vehicles used for recreational purposes.

- 1 (a) The parking of any noncommercial vehicle(s) used for
 2 recreational purposes listed in this chapter shall be
 3 permitted in any residentially zoned district of the city,
 4 subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) Said vehicle(s) shall be parked only on the property which is the residence or place of abode of the owner of said vehicle.

(2) Registration:

- (a) Said vehicle(s) which, pursuant to state law, must be registered or licensed, shall have a current registration and/or license.
- (b) The property owner, or tenant of said property shall register each noncommercial vehicle used for recreational purposes annually with the City by applying for a permit through Building and Code Services. The individual registering the noncommercial vehicle used for recreational purposes with the City's Building and Code Services shall be the same individual who is identified on the state of Florida vehicle registration form.
- (c) Registration stickers will be issued for each noncommercial vehicle used for recreational purposes and

- shall be affixed to said vehicle. The owner or tenant shall ensure that the registration sticker is available for inspection and visible from the street. In those instances where the noncommercial vehicle used for recreational purposes is parked behind a fence or other screening, the owner/tenant must produce a copy of the sticker or registration documentation upon request by an authorized city representative. The registration sticker for noncommercial vehicles used for recreational purposes is valid for one year from the date of issuance.
- (3) Said vehicle(s) shall not be parked on any public dedicated street, sidewalk or right-of-way (including any swale or parkway).
- (4) Said vehicle(s) shall be parked only in backyards or side yards such that no portion of the vehicle protrudes past, or in front of facades of any residence. The surface utilized to drive said vehicle from the street to the back or side yard shall be an improved surface constructed and permitted by the City of Margate Building and Code Services Department. Maintenance of this improved surface shall be the same as provided for by Sec. 35-0.2.

As an exception to the immediately preceding paragraph, a noncommercial vehicle(s) <u>used for recreational purposes</u> may be parked in any driveway or any area constructed and permitted by the <u>Bbuilding and Code Services Ddepartment</u> of the <u>Ceity</u>, <u>so long as it does not block line of site creating a potential safety hazard. In addition, noncommercial vehicles used for recreational purposes shall not occupy a parking space which results in the owner or tenant to park any other vehicle on the front lawn of the residential property or in the public right of way.</u>

- (5) Said vehicle(s) shall not display commercial lettering nor have any equipment, materials, or devices associated with a commercial or industrial use visible. The existence of such lettering, equipment, materials or devices shall automatically deem the vehicle as a "commercial vehicle," subject to the provisions of section 26-2 above.
- (6) Said vehicle(s) shall not exceed thirty-five (35) feet in length from the front to the back.
- (b) The parking of any noncommercial vehicle(s) used for recreational purposes listed in this chapter shall be

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prohibited in any nonresidential zoning district, unless the property whereon said vehicle is parked contains a bona fide business involving the sales, storage, or repair of such vehicle(s). Parking for customers and individuals doing business with an establishment for which parking is provided shall constitute an accessory use under this provision, and therefore shall not be prohibited.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the City of Margate Code, and that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article" or such
