





#### Method of Procedure - Sequencing and Operational Continuity

Razorback LLC understands that maintaining uninterrupted wastewater treatment operations is a fundamental requirement of the City's Headworks Rehabilitation project. Our Method of Procedure (MOP) reflects our deep experience executing similar upgrades within active wastewater treatment facilities — where careful coordination, phased execution, and proactive risk management are critical to success.

Our MOP is designed to align construction activities with the City's operational priorities, treatment flows, and safety standards. It will be refined in collaboration with City staff during preconstruction and integrated into the project's Quality Control and Safety Plans.

#### 1. Sequenced Construction Execution

We will implement a phased approach that isolates each work zone while ensuring influent flow, odor control, and operator access are maintained at all times. Key sequencing strategies include:

- Initial Condition Assessment: Conduct pre-construction walkthroughs and assessments of all systems and structures involved to validate existing conditions and coordinate phasing with City staff.
- Bypass System Design and Installation: Install temporary bypass pumping systems and odor control measures as needed to route influent flows around construction zones with no service interruption.
- Demolition and Prep in Phases: Carefully sequence removal of deteriorated structures, gates, or mechanical systems in designated zones, with structural and temporary supports as necessary.
- Rehabilitation and New Work: Execute repairs or replacements using pre-approved materials and methods, integrating prefabricated elements where possible to reduce on-site construction time.
- Functional Testing and Commissioning: Each component will be tested in isolation before integration
  with active plant systems, minimizing risk during tie-in activities.

Only one critical structure or channel will be taken offline at a time, ensuring redundancy and maintaining required treatment capacities throughout construction.



### 2. Operational Coordination and Communication

We will establish clear and continuous lines of communication with City operations and maintenance staff:

- Daily Coordination Meetings: A Razorback Superintendent will conduct daily on-site coordination meetings with plant staff to review progress, upcoming activities, and any required utility isolations or access changes.
- Advanced Shutdown Notifications: All shutdowns or transitions will be identified in advance and approved by the City. Detailed written procedures will be submitted and reviewed with operations personnel.
- Tie-in and Live Work Procedures: All tie-ins or modifications to live systems will be performed during scheduled low-flow periods or night/weekend hours, with full City oversight and standby capacity in place.

### 3. Safety and Regulatory Integration

All construction activity will follow strict safety protocols tailored to the facility's operational environment:

- Confined Space and Elevated Work Plans: Each work area will be evaluated for confined space or fall hazards. OSHA-compliant protocols, training certifications, and rescue plans will be enforced.
- Contamination and Bypass Risk Control: All bypass pumping and influent diversion activities will
  include double containment, redundancy, and real-time flow monitoring to prevent spills or process
  disruptions.
- Compliance with FDEP Standards: All work will conform to FDEP permitting and operational standards, and any activities impacting process flow or system performance will be reviewed with regulatory implications in mind.

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### 4. Contingency Planning and Flexibility

We recognize that conditions may change rapidly during construction in an operational facility. To prepare for this, Razorback will:

- Maintain Standby Crews and Redundant Systems: Key trades will remain on-call for critical path or emergency activities. Redundant bypass capacity will be installed for high-risk transitions.
- Develop Alternate Phasing Plans: We will identify and pre-approve alternate work sequences with City input in the event of weather impacts, unforeseen obstructions, or utility conflicts.
- Maintain a Live Risk Register: Updated weekly during construction, this tool will track operational, safety, and schedule risks and serve as a shared platform for early detection and joint problemsolving.

#### Summary

Razorback's MOP reflects lessons learned from prior headworks and influent system rehabilitations where operational continuity, public safety, and regulatory compliance could not be compromised. This methodical, communication-driven approach ensures that the City's critical infrastructure remains protected, treatment service remains uninterrupted, and the project proceeds on schedule with minimal disruption.
