1) PUBLIC HEARING(S)

A. [ID 2024-271](#) PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AND BUDGET

CITY MANAGER, CALE CURTIS, explained the protocol for the City Commission Budget Hearing.

There was no Public Discussion for this Item.

2) RESOLUTION(S)

A. [ID 2024-275](#) APPROVING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE CITY OF MARGATE FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025 IN THE AMOUNT OF 7.5667 MILLS PER THOUSAND DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION (WHICH INCLUDES 0.4496 FOR VOTED DEBT SERVICE); THAT THE OPERATING MILLAGE RATE OF 7.1171 IS 8.89% HIGHER THAN THE ROLLED-BACK RATE OF 6.5360.

A motion was made by Vice Mayor Schwartz, seconded by Commissioner Caggiano, that this Resolution, should be approved.

COMMISSIONER, ANTONIO V. ARSERIO, explained that the City was not raising taxes and said that the overall millage rate decreased.

The motion carried by the following vote:

CITY ATTORNEY, DAVID N. TOLCES, re-read the Resolution pertaining to the millage rate.

3) ORDINANCE(S) - SECOND READING

- A.** [ID 2024-276](#) ADOPTING AN OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2024 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2025; PROVIDING FOR A BUDGET FOR THE GENERAL FUND, SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS, DEBT SERVICE FUNDS, CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDS, ENTERPRISE FUNDS, AND AN INTERNAL SERVICE FUND; PROVIDING FOR A MILLAGE RATE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A motion was made by Vice Mayor Schwartz, seconded by Commissioner Caggiano, that this Ordinance, Second Reading, should be approved.

MAYOR, TOMMY RUZZANO, thanked everyone for their work on the Budget and said that it demonstrated good leadership.

VICE MAYOR, ARLENE R. SCHWARTZ, concurred with Mayor Ruzzano's comments.

The motion carried by the following vote:

VICE MAYOR SCHWARTZ explained that she would not be attending the City Commission Meeting that followed as she would be visiting Coconut Creek High School for a meeting pertaining to keeping Liberty Elementary School open.

COMMISSIONER ARSERIO advised that he too would be joining Vice Mayor Schwartz and would not attend the next City Commission Meeting.

MAYOR RUZZANO discussed the potential closure of Liberty Elementary School.

Discussion ensued.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:12pm.
