SCOTT, ESQ., GREENSPOON MARDER, LLP FOR DOUGLAS BRAWN, MARGATE ACQISITION, LLC, OF THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT VARIANCE (25-00400057)DECISION APPROVING/DENYING, THE VARIANCE TO REDUCE PARKING REQUIREMENTS, WAIVE CERTAIN INTERIOR AND PERIMETER LANDSCAPE REQUIREMENTS, MODIFY A NONCONFORMING STRUCTURE TO MAKE IT LESS CONFORMING WITH CODE REQUIREMENTS FOR PURPOSE OF CONVERTING THE ΑN CONGREGATE LIVING FACILITY TO A 174-UNIT MULTIFAMILY DEVELOPMENT THAT PROVIDES 250 PARKING SPACES AT 5600 LAKESIDE DRIVE.

Greenspoon Marder, LLP, agent for Douglas Brawn, Margate Acquisition, LLC ("Applicant") submitted variance application 25-00400057 to the Board of Adjustment to request a reduction in required parking from 381 parking spaces to 250 parking spaces, waive perimeter landscape buffer and interior landscape island requirements, and for permission to modify a nonconforming structure to make it less conforming with Code requirements at 5600 Lakeside Drive; and

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2025 the Board of Adjustment voted 3-0 to deny the application ; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2025 the Applicant requested an appeal to this Board of Adjustment decision.
