2) PUBLIC DISCUSSION

MAYOR, ARLENE R. SCHWARTZ, explained the protocol for submitting Public Discussion.

TRACY VAN WINKLE suggested that all children should be recognized for all that they did and referenced Students and Teachers of the Month.

DONNA FELLOWS thanked the City Commission and hoped that they would attend the Breakfast with Santa event on Saturday helping homeless children in their school system. She hoped that Margate's Winter Festival was going to be bigger and better this year.

JONATHAN KRALJIC read a list of initiatives for Mayor Schwartz to consider for her to accomplish during her term.

ELSA SANCHEZ read a statement pertaining to Commissioner Simone being overlooked.

THE LEGACY CLOSET, MARGI BRE, (of PARKLAND) thanked the City for helping them coordinate the forthcoming homeless event for breakfast with Santa and continued to discuss the same.

RICHARD ZUCCHINI, LAKEWOOD CIRCLE E, explained that the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) had a very big job and recommended that it should be expanded to include experienced qualified personnel. He also suggested that the CRA should also have officer elections and that it needed to be discussed.

COMMISSIONER, ANTHONY N. CAGGIANO, questioned if the CRA discussion could be placed on the next City Commission's Agenda.

MAYOR SCHWARTZ confirmed that they could.

COMMISSIONER, TOMMY RUZZANO, said that the CRA only had just under two years and questioned if there was something that the Chair was doing that Mr. Zucchini did not approve.

Discussion ensued.

CITY ATTORNEY, DAVID N. TOLCES, advised that the maximum number of CRA board members permitted are seven and that the proposed Item would need to be on a 2025 Agenda if agreed upon together with the considerations for the Chair and Vice Chair positions.

MAYOR SCHWARTZ polled the City Commission if they wanted to add the CRA board item to the next Agenda.

Commissioner Ruzzano - Had no problem with it; Commissioner Caggiano - Had no problem with it; Commissioner Simone - Had no problem with it; and Mayor Schwartz - Had no problem with it.

Poll results: 4 - 0.

LAUREN BERACHA discussed Commissioner Simone being bypassed again.
