A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE AWARD OF BID NO. 2021-006 - SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD SERVICES TO THE BUTLER GROUP OF SOUTH FLORIDA, LLC D/B/A NEXTAFF, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17.89 PER HOUR FOR CROSSING GUARDS AND SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL; PROVIDING FOR TERM; PROVIDING FOR RENEWAL WITHOUT FURTHER COMMISSION ACTION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida, approves awarding Bid No. 2021-006 - School Crossing Guard Services, to The Butler Group of South Florida, LLC d/b/a Nextaff in the amount of \$17.89 per hour for crossing guards and supervisory personnel.


SECTION 2: That the Mayor and City Manager are authorized and directed to execute a contract for the above, or the administration is authorized to issue a purchase order to implement same.
