A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING DONATION OF \$2,000.00 TO THE SOUTH FLORIDA REHAB AND EMERGENCY SUPPORT TEAM, INC. (SFREST), ALSO KNOW AS "CANTEEN", TO PROVIDE FOR SERVICE AND SUPPORT TO PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENTS WITHIN PALM BEACH AND BROWARD COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR FUNDING FROM THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida, approves the donation of \$2,000 to the South Florida Rehab and Emergency Support Team (SFREST), also known as Canteen, utilizing funds from the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund, to provide for service and support to public safety departments within Palm Beach and Broward County.

SECTION 2: That the donation is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

SECTION 3: The Chief of Police recommends the donation to SFREST in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") for service and support to public safety departments within Palm Beach and Broward County.

SECTION 4: The Chief of Police certifies that the donation to SFREST for service and support to public safety departments within Palm Beach and Broward County in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

SECTION 5: The Chief of Police certifies that the donation to SFREST in State LETFs for the service and support to public safety departments within Palm Beach and Broward County, in that the funds are not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Police Department.

SECTION 6: The Chief of Police certifies that the donation to SFREST of State LETFs for service and support to public safety departments within Palm Beach and Broward County in that the funds were not considered in the adoption and approval of the Police

Department budget.

SECTION 7: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
