## 1) PUBLIC HEARING(S)

## A. <u>ID 2023-260</u> PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AND BUDGET

CITY MANAGER CALE CURTIS advised that from the first hearing until today, they had incorporated the changes that were directed by the City Commission.

MAYOR ANTHONY N. CAGGIANO opened and explained the protocol for submitting comments to Public Discussion during this City Commission Budget Hearing.

JONATHAN A. KRALJIC, 7357 FLORES WAY, read a statement pertaining to Resolution 2) A., ID 2023-317 and questioned whether the City Commission were elected officials or City employees.

# 2) **RESOLUTION(S)**

A. <u>ID 2023-317</u> RESOLUTION - PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE SALARIES OF THE CITY COMMISSIONERS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

A motion was made by Commissioner Arserio, seconded by Commissioner Schwartz, that this Resolution, should be approved.

ELSA J. SANCHEZ, 6930 NW 15TH STREET, read a statement outlining her concerns on this Item.

LAUREN BERACHA, 6950 NW 14TH PLACE, highlighted her concerns on this Item and suggested that the City Commission should reconsider the salary increase.

KEVIN L. WARD, 6711 NW 8 CT., disagreed with the salary increase.

MR. KRALJIC requested the City Commission to decline the salary increase and go forth with changing the City's Charter to allow the voters to decide their pay.

LINDA R. STEWARD, 6367 NW 19 CT., said it was her first time attending a City meeting and she did not understand why the City Commissioners were asking for a 12% raise when the teachers were only asking for 7.5%.

DONNA L. FELLOWS, 6108 NW 9TH COURT, thought the salary increase was absurd.

COMMISSIONER JOANNE SIMONE hoped that she could get at least two of her fellow City Commissioners to agree with her that this increase was outrageous.

- APPROVING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE CITY OF MARGATE FISCAL ID 2023-259 Β. YEAR 2023/2024 IN THE AMOUNT OF 7.6004 MILLS PER THOUSAND (WHICH DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION **INCLUDES** .4833 FOR VOTED DEBT SERVICE); THAT THE OPERATING MILLAGE RATE OF 7.1171 IS 9.44% HIGHER THAN THE ROLLED-BACK RATE OF 6.5031.

A motion was made by Commissioner Schwartz, seconded by Commissioner Arserio, that this Resolution, should be approved.

CITY MANAGER CURTIS clarified that the millage rate was not increasing as the City was keeping the operating millage rate the same and the debt service millage rate was being lowered.

Discussion ensued.

PROJECTS FUNDS, ENTERPRISE FUNDS, AND INTERNAL SERVICE FUND; PROVIDING PROVIDING FOR А MILLAGE RATE; FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
