7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE,
8 FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 2-73 -
9 APPOINTMENT PROCEDURES FOR BOARDS AND
10 COMMITTEES; PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT AND
11 APPLICATION PROCEDURES; PROVIDING FOR
12 SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION;
13 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
17 MARGATE, FLORIDA:
18

19 Section 1: Chapter 2 Administration, Article IV
20 Boards, Committees, etc., Division I Generally, Section
21 2-73 is hereby amended to read as follows:

24 Sec. 2-73. - Appointment and application procedures for
25 boards and committees.

26 A. Appointment Procedures

27 (1) All Boards and Committees of the City of Margate
28 shall be appointed by majority vote of the City
29 Commission utilizing the procedure provided in
30 subsection B. below.

31 ~~(a)~~ (2) Simultaneous with the second commission meeting in
32 March January 2013, the term of each individual sitting
33 on any board or committee of the City of Margate shall
34 be deemed to have expired.

36 ~~(b)~~ (3) At the second city commission meeting in March
37 January 2013, and every year thereafter each
38 commissioner the City Commission of the City of Margate
39 shall make one (1) appointments to each of the boards
40 and committees shall appoint five (5) members of each
41 City board for a term of one year.

3 ~~(c) At the second city commission meeting in January 2013,~~
4 ~~in which there are existing vacancies pursuant to~~
5 ~~paragraph (a). The city commission shall ratify each~~
6 ~~commissioner's appointment.~~

9 ~~(d) The term of each board member or committee member~~
10 ~~appointed pursuant to paragraph (b) shall expire~~
11 ~~simultaneous with the first commission meeting in~~
12 ~~January 2015.~~

14 ~~(e) At the first commission meeting in January 2017 2015,~~
15 ~~each board member or committee member shall be~~
16 ~~appointed or reappointed, as provided in paragraph (b)~~
17 ~~above, for a term which shall expire upon the~~
18 ~~appointment of a successor at the first meeting of~~
19 ~~January 2017.~~

22 ~~(f) All subsequent board or committee members shall be~~
23 ~~appointed at two year intervals by the procedure~~
24 ~~provided in paragraphs (a) through (d) above.~~

26 ~~(g) (4) Upon a vacancy of any board or committee, prior to~~
27 ~~the full term of any board member or committee member,~~
28 ~~a vacancy shall be filled as provided in section B. by~~
29 ~~selection of the commissioner (or successor to the~~
30 ~~seat of the commissioner) who had appointed the board~~
31 ~~member or committee member who vacated that position.~~
32 ~~The selection shall be ratified by the city commission~~
33 ~~within thirty (30) days of the vacancy.~~

36 ~~(g) (5) Exempted from the above shall be any board or~~
37 ~~committee appointed by the administration or composed~~
38 ~~solely of city-employed staff, or any board or~~
39 ~~committee appointed or elected as provided for by~~
40 ~~federal law, state statute or the Charter of the City~~

1 of Margate; the Community Redevelopment Agency Board
2 of the City of Margate; the Board of the Northwest
3 Focal Point Senior Center District; or the Recreation
4 Foundation.

6 (6) Temporary boards or committees that are formed by
7 resolution of the City Commission shall also be exempt
8 from this ordinance.
9

10 B. Application Procedures

11 1) Individuals wishing to be considered for any
12 vacancy on any board or committee, shall submit an
13 application to the Office of the City Clerk not later
14 than fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting in which
15 the City Commission shall fill said vacancy. The
16 application shall include a request for qualification
17 specific to the board or committee to which the
18 individual is applying.

19 2) Incumbents who wish to be considered for
20 reappointment to a particular board must comply with
21 the preceding subsection.

22 3) Applications shall not be considered for any
23 applicant to any board or committee which was
24 submitted more than two years prior to the date which
25 an applicant could be appointed.

28 SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
29 conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to
30 the extent of such conflict.

31
32 SECTION 3: If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase
33 of this ordinance is held to be invalid or
34 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
35 then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of
36 the remaining portions of this ordinance.
37


1 SECTION 4: It is the intention of the City Commission
2 that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be
3 made a part of the City of Margate Code, and that the
4 sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered
5 and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section",
6 "article" or such other appropriate word or phrase in
7 order to accomplish such intentions.
8


9 SECTION 5: This ordinance shall become effective
10 immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
11
