VEHICLE AND STAFFING STRUCTURE:	Emergency Medical Services. The CITY shall provide the advanced life support ("ALS") rescue/transport vehicles and BSO shall provide the Personnel for each vehicle and for the provision of emergency medical services as follows:
	Station 18 shall have one NFPA compliant standard ALS rescue/transport vehicle (including stretchers) with three personnel, One Officer and two Firefighter/paramedics.
	Station 58 shall have one NFPA compliant standard ALS rescue/transport vehicles (including stretchers) each with three personnel, One Officer and two Firefighter/paramedics.
	Station 98 shall have one NFPA compliant standard ALS rescue/transport vehicles (including stretchers) with three personnel, One Officer and two Firefighter/paramedics.
	Staffing on each standard ALS rescue/transport vehicle shall be as follows:
	One company officer (lieutenant or captain) Two firefighters
	All of the above personnel shall be cross-trained firefighter/paramedics.
	The CITY shall provide two reserve NFPA compliant standard ALS rescue/transport vehicles, stationed within the CITY, for use as a replacement vehicle during times a regular vehicle is out of service due to repairs or maintenance, which shall be stationed in one of the stations, as described above. In the event that an additional reserve vehicle is needed, BSO shall provide the additional reserve vehicle, at no additional cost to the CITY.

Fire Protection Services. The CITY shall provide the apparatus and BSO shall provide the Personnel for the provision of fire protection services as follows (except as otherwise specified):

Station 18 shall have one NFPA 1901 fire apparatus/ALS first responder engine vehicle with three personnel, one NFPA 1901 fire apparatus/ALS first responder aerial vehicle with three personnel.

Station 58 shall have one NFPA 1901 fire apparatus/ALS first responder suppression vehicle with three personnel.

Station 98 shall have one NFPA 1901 fire apparatus/ALS first responder suppression vehicle with three personnel.

Staffing on each fire apparatus/ALS first responder engine/aerial vehicle shall be as follows:

One company officer (lieutenant or captain)
One driver engineer
One firefighter

All of the above personnel shall be cross-trained firefighter/paramedics.

The CITY shall provide one NFPA 1901 reserve fire apparatus/ALS first responder engine, stationed within the CITY, for use as a replacement vehicle during times a regular vehicle is out of service due to repairs or maintenance, which shall be stationed in one of the stations, as described above. In the event that an additional reserve vehicle is needed, BSO shall provide the additional reserve vehicle, at no additional cost to the CITY.

Fire Prevention Services. The City shall be provided the following by BSO for the provision of fire prevention services:

One Lieutenant or one Captain certified by the State of Florida and Broward County as a Fire Safety Inspector.

Two Firefighters certified by the State of Florida and Broward County as a Fire Safety Inspector.

All vehicles, equipment and personnel to perform Fire Prevention Services.

	The Consideration provided for under this Agreement includes the cost of the vehicles required to be provided by BSO, which shall be maintained in good working condition, for administrative Fire Prevention Services.
