Dear Mr. Sloan,

As you may be aware, on October 28, 2020, the City of Margate migrated from the Central Square KT Transaction online payment solution to the AMS/Bridgepay online solution.

Since then we have experienced an ongoing issue with transactions not automatically booking into the cash receipt batch, as required. This has resulted in an expenditure of countless hours of City staff time spent reconciling accounts. Eighteen months after the migration, the absence of a resolution to this issue by AMS's IT staff, or any apparent hope thereof, has led to the City's decision to terminate our Utility Billing Division's relationship with AMS.

In accordance with the terms of our contract, this letter shall serve as formal notification of the termination of our Merchant Processing agreement for the two Utility Billing accounts (Merchant number: 317730242303 and 317730242293) effective December 17, 2022.
