A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING PARTIAL FUNDING OF THE NATIONAL NIGHT OUT EVENT TO BE HELD AUGUST 2, 2022, TO PROMOTE COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN CRIME PREVENTION AND POLICE-COMMUNITY NEIGHBORHOOD SPIRIT POLICE COMMUNITY RELATIONS, AND TO ENCOURAGE NEIGHBORHOOD CAMARADERIE AS PART OF THE FIGHT FOR SAFER STREETS; APPROVING WAIVING OF BIDDING POLICE AWARENESS PROMOTIONAL PROVIDING FOR FUNDING NOT TO EXCEED \$35,000 FROM THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND; PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FROM GENERAL FUND AND DONATIONS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida, approves the expenditure of up to \$35,000.00 for "National Night Out", to be held on August 2, 2022, utilizing funds from the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund, and authorizing waiving of bidding for the purchase of police awareness promotional items.

SECTION 2: That the expenditure is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

 $\underline{\textbf{SECTION 3}}\colon$ The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") for "National Night Out".

 $\underline{\textbf{SECTION 4}}$: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure for "National Night Out" in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

 $\underline{\textbf{SECTION 5}}\colon$ The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure in State LETFs for "National Night Out", in that the funds are not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Police Department.
