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| 1. <i>Sparkler sales</i> - submittal of inventory and site plan required | \$ 150 400.00 |
| 2. <i>Fireworks, public display</i> . Public display of fireworks must be under the direction of a person certified by the fire code official as a fireworks "shooter".
Shooter certification required application to establish competency in handling fireworks and determining compliance with applicable state regulations. | \$ 175 450.00 |
| 3. <i>Combustible fiber and baled storage</i> . Storage and handling of quantities exceeding one hundred (100) cubic feet. | \$ 75 50.00 |
| 4. <i>Compressed gases</i> . Storage, handling, or use of more than two thousand (2,000) cubic feet of flammable gas or six thousand (6,000) cubic feet of nonflammable gas at normal temperature and pressure. | \$ 200 475.00 |
| 5. <i>Explosives</i> . Manufacturing, keeping, storage, sale and transportation of explosives. | \$ 175 450.00 |
| 6. <i>Garages</i> . Place of business for servicing or repairing of motor vehicle | \$ 175 450.00 |
| 7. <i>Flammable finishes application</i> . Spraying or dipping operations utilizing on any working day more than one (1) gallon of flammable or combustible liquids. | \$ 175 450.00 |
| 8. <i>Flammable and combustible liquids</i> . Storage, handling or use of class 1A and 1B liquids in excess of one (1) gallon in a place of human habitation; in excess of six (6) gallons in other occupancies; or in excess of ten (10) gallons outside any building. | \$ 175 450.00 |
| 9. <i>Hazardous chemical</i> . Storage, handling, or use of any hazardous materials. | \$ 125 400.00 |
| 10. <i>Liquefied petroleum gas</i> . A permit shall be required for each installation of liquefied petroleum gas employing a container or an aggregate of interconnected containers of over two thousand (2,000) gallons of water capacity. | \$ 200 475.00 |
| 11. <i>Oil-burning equipment</i> . Installation or replacement of an oil burner and fuel tank that is in excess of sixty (60) gallons outside of a building. | \$ 75 50.00 |
| 12. <i>Organic coatings manufacturing</i> . | \$ 75 50.00 |
| 13. <i>Welding or cutting operations</i> . Excludes work conducted on job sites. | \$ 100 75.00 |
