ORDINANCE NO.

ORDINANCE OF  $\mathtt{THE}$ CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND REFERENDUM TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY ADMINISTRATION FOR THE ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 4, 2014, ESTABLISHING THE SUBJECT OF THE REFERENDUM TO BEFOLLOWS: AS AMENDMENT FOR CITY DEPARTMENTS, DIRECTOR, OFFICES, AGENCIES AND BOARDS, CONTRACTS, PURCHASES AND BID AWARDS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Administration is hereby authorized and directed, and the appropriate County authorities are authorized and directed, to place special referendum questions on the November 4, 2014 ballot, providing for the questions to be applicable only to the City of Margate.

SECTION 2: The form of the question to be placed on the ballot as referred to above shall appear as follows:

# QUESTION

"Charter amendment for City departments, director, offices, agencies and boards, contracts, purchases and bid awards."

"Shall the Charter of Margate be amended for proper names for Fire-Rescue Department and Human Resources Director; the City Manager to establish, consolidate, combine, or dissolve departments and offices except Charter offices, removing the Civil Service Board from the Charter, noticing City Commission of emergency purchases within 24 hours when practicable, and for contracts, purchases and bid awards to be authorized by the City Manager unless Commission approval is required by City ordinance?"

SECTION 3: That the referendum election called for by this ordinance shall be a binding referendum. Upon passage of the question framed in Section 2 of this ordinance, Section 3.09 of the Charter of the City of Margate shall be amended to provide:

# Section 3.09. City departments, offices, agencies and boards.

The following are hereby created and permanently established as departments and boards of the City of Margate, Florida:

- (1) The Police Department of the City of Margate;
- (2) The Fire-Rescue Department of the City of Margate;
- (3) The Planning and Zoning Board of the City of Margate;
- (4) The Board of Adjustment of the City of Margate; and
- (5) The Civil Service Board. The city commission may establish by ordinance all further city departments, offices, agencies and boards and shall prescribe their functions and duties, subject to this Charter, by ordinance.
- (5) (6) The City Commission may establish by ordinance all further City agencies and boards and shall prescribe their functions and duties, subject to this Charter, by ordinance.
- (6) (7) The City Manager may establish, consolidate, combine, or dissolve all further City departments and offices and shall prescribe the functions and duties of all City Departments except for the Department of the City Clerk and City Attorney. Funding for departments and offices shall be as provided for in the City budget, or by budget amendment, as approved by the City Commission.

SECTION 4: That the referendum election called for by this ordinance shall be a binding referendum. Upon passage of the question framed in Section 2 of this ordinance, Section 7.01 of the Charter of the City of Margate shall be amended to provide:

## Section 7.01. Creation of board.

A civil service board for the City of Margate is hereby created. This board shall be composed of five (5) members who shall take office as follows:

- (1) Two (2) members shall be appointed by the <u>Ccity</u> Ccommission;
- -(2) One (1) member shall be elected by the employees of the City of Margate;
- -(3) One (1) member shall be elected by the employees of the City of Margate and shall be an employee of the City of Margate;
- -(4) One (1) member shall be appointed by the four (4) previously appointed and elected members.

Each member shall be appointed or elected for a term of two (2) years.

SECTION 5: That the referendum election called for by this ordinance shall be a binding referendum. Upon passage of the question framed in Section 2 of this ordinance, Section 4.08 of the Charter of the City of Margate shall be amended to provide:

#### Section 4.08. Powers and duties of city manager.

The <u>Ceity Mmanager</u> shall be the chief administrative and executive officer of the <u>Ceity</u>. He/she may head one or more departments and shall be responsible to the <u>Ceity Ceommission</u> for the proper administration of all affairs of the city. To that end he/she shall have the power and shall be required to:

(a) Appoint and, when necessary for the good of the <u>Ceity</u>, suspend or remove all employees of the <u>Ceity</u> except as otherwise provided by the <u>Ceity</u> Charter or law, and except as he/she may authorize the head of a department or office to suspend or remove subordinates in such department or office.

This power of appointment, suspension and removal shall include the power to appoint and suspend or remove all department heads in the Ceity, except that the Ceity

<u>Ce</u>ommission reserves to itself the power of appointment, suspension and removal of the following:

- (1) The attorneys for the  $\underline{Ceity}$ ; and
- (2) The Ceity Celerk for the Ceity.
- (b) Prepare the budget annually and submit it to the  $\underline{\text{Ce}}$ ommission for approval, together with a message describing the important features, and be responsible for administration after adoption by the Ceommission.
- (c) Prepare and submit to the  $\underline{Ce}$ ommission at the end of the fiscal year a complete report on the finances and administrative activities of the city for the preceding year.
- (d) Keep the <u>Ceommission</u> advised of the financial condition and future needs of the <u>Ceity</u> on a monthly basis and make such recommendations as he/she may deem desirable.
- (e) Recommend to the governing body a standard schedule of pay for each appointive office and position in the  $\underline{Ce}$ ity service, including minimum, intermediate and maximum rates.
- (f) Recommend to the governing body from time to time the adoption of such measures as he/she may deem necessary or expedient for the health, safety or welfare of the community or for the improvement of administrative services.
- (g) Consolidate or combine offices, positions, departments or units under his/her jurisdiction, with prior approval of the city commission.

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- (h) Attend all meetings of the Ceity Ceommission therefrom take unless excused and part in all discussion of matters coming before the commission, but he/she shall not vote. He/she shall be entitled to notice of all regular and special meetings of the Ceommission and shall have the power to call special meetings of the Ceity Ceommission.
- (i) Investigate and determine whether purchases of current supplies and contractual services are made in accordance with regulations prescribed by Charter and ordinance and whether competitive conditions are maintained in a fair and impartial manner.
- (j) See that all laws and ordinances are duly enforced.
- (k) Investigate the affairs of the Ceity or any or division thereof; investigate department all complaints in relation to matters concerning the administration of the government of the City and in regard to service maintained by the public utilities in the City; and see that all franchises, permits and privileges granted by the C<del>c</del>ity are faithfully observed and, upon knowledge of any violation thereof, call same to the attention of the Ceity Aattorney and the Ceity Ceommission.
- (1) Devote his entire time to the discharge of his/her official duties.
- (m) Perform such other duties as may be required by the  $\underline{Ce}$ ommission not inconsistent with the City Charter, law or ordinances.
- (n) Shall be responsible for supervising the acquisition of all available grants.
- SECTION 6: That the referendum election called for by this ordinance shall be a binding referendum. Upon passage of the

questions framed in Section 2 of this ordinance, Section 7.02 of the Charter of the City of Margate shall be amended to provide:

# Section 7.02. Personnel system.

- (1) Merit principle. All appointments and promotions of  $\underline{Ce}$ ity officers and employees shall be made solely on the basis of merit and fitness demonstrated by examination or other evidence of competence.
- (2) <u>Personnel Human Resources Delirector</u>. There shall be a <u>personnel Human Resources Delirector</u> appointed by the <u>Ceity Memanager</u> as provided in <u>Section 4.08</u>, who shall administer the personnel system of the Ceity.
- (3) Personnel rules. The <u>Human Resources personnel</u> director shall prepare personnel rules. The city manager shall refer such proposed rules to the civil service board, which shall report to the city manager its recommendations thereon. When approved by the <u>Ce</u>ity <u>M</u>manager, the rules shall be proposed to the <u>Ce</u>ommission, and the <u>Ce</u>ommission may by ordinance adopt them with or without amendment.

 $\underline{\mathtt{SECTION}\ 7}\colon$  That the referendum election called for by this ordinance shall be a binding referendum. Upon passage of the questions framed in Section 2 of this ordinance, Section 4.10 of the Charter of the City of Margate shall be amended to provide:

#### Section 4.10. Contracts.

All contracts must be authorized by the <u>City Manager unless</u> required to be approved by the <u>Ceity Ceommission</u>, as determined by ordinance of the City. Where contracts are approved by the <u>City Commission</u>, they must be signed by the <u>City Manager</u>, and the <u>Mayor</u>, or <u>Vice Mayor</u>. <del>Countersigning of contracts [is] required, with the city manager and mayor or vice-mayor signing</del>.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 8}}$ : That the referendum election called for by this ordinance shall be a binding referendum. Upon passage of the question framed in Section 2 of this ordinance, Section 5.08 of the Charter of the City of Margate shall be amended to provide:

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# Section 4.12. Emergencies.

In case of accident, disaster or other circumstances creating a public emergency, the Ceity Mmanager may award contracts and make purchases for the purpose of meeting said emergency; but he/she shall file with the Ceommission within a twenty-four-hour period, whenever practicable, a certificate showing such emergency and the necessity for such action, together with an itemized account of all expenditures. (Note: This provision subject to Florida law on this subject.)

SECTION 9: That the referendum election called for by this ordinance shall be a binding referendum. Upon passage of the question framed in Section 2 of this ordinance, Section 5.08 of the Charter of the City of Margate shall be amended to provide:

## Section 5.08. Contracts.

Contracts shall be authorized by the Ccity Ccommission, with countersigning by the Ccity Mmanager and the Mmayor or Vvice-Mmayor signing.

That the referendum election called for by this ordinance shall be a binding referendum. Upon passage of the question framed in Section 2 of this ordinance, Section 4.11 of the Charter of the City of Margate shall be amended to provide:

#### Section 4.11. Purchases and bid awards.

The Ceity Mmanager may authorize purchases and bid awards on behalf of the Ceity when individual expenditures do not exceed an amount provided for by ordinance of the City the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00).

SECTION 11: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 12: If any part, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, phrase, clause, term, or work of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction of
