ORDINANCE NO. 2013-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2009-11; PROVIDING
FOR THE DUTIES OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE
NORTHWEST FOCAL POINT SENIOR CENTER
DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Northwest Focal Point Senior Center was
created in 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Focal Point Senior Center has been a
resource for the seniors residing within the City of Margate,
northwest Broward County and Broward County in general; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Focal Point Senior Center District
was created by ordinance of the City of Margate on August 19,
2009; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2009-11 provided that the District Board
has the final responsibility for control of District
facilities and properties, use of resources, hiring of the
District Director, financing improvements, and approving all
contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to provide for a
mechanism for the District Board to meet their
responsibilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the
City of Margate that:

Section 1: Section 5 of Ordinance 2009-11 is amended as
follows:

The "District Board" of the Northwest Focal Point Senior
Center District shall be composed of each duly elected member

1 of the City Commission of the City of Margate. The term of
2 each Board Member shall be concurrent with each Member's term
3 on the Margate City Commission. The Mayor of the City of
4 Margate shall function as the Chair of the "District Board"
5 and the Vice Mayor as the Vice Chair. Procedures of the
6 District Board shall be those adopted by the Margate City
7 Commission unless otherwise adopted by resolution of the
8 District Board.

10 The District Board shall be the policy making body of the
11 District and have final responsibility for:

13 (a) Exercising control over facilities and properties
14 (b) Controlling the use of resources generated by the
15 Northwest Focal Point Senior Center
16 (c) Approving the hiring and all employment related
17 matters as to the Project Director of the Northwest Focal
18 Point Senior Center ~~(Project Director)~~. and day to day
19 oversight of the Project Director and operations of the
20 District. However, the preceding may be delegated by
21 resolution to a the City Manager of the City of Margate or
22 his/her designee contractual agent. The hiring and all
23 employment related matters pertaining to all other personnel
24 of the District shall be the responsibility of the
25 aforementioned Director with approval of the City Manager.
26 (d) Financing Improvements
27 (e) Approving all contracts and agreements

29 Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
30 conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to the
31 extent of such conflict.

33 SECTION 3: If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of
34 this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a
35 court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no
36 way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
37 ordinance.

39 SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective
40 immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
