AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPENDIX A ZONING, ARTICLE II DEFINITIONS, SECTION 2.2 TERMS DEFINED; ARTICLE III GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 3.20 SHEDS, STORAGE BUILDINGS, AND TEMPORARY STORAGE STRUCTURES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS; PROVIDING FOR MAXIMUM STANDARDS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Appendix A Zoning, Article II Definitions Section 2.2 Terms defined is hereby amended to add as follows:

Section 2.2 Terms defined.

Shed: A permanent, simple roofed structure, typically made of wood or metal with four sides enclosed, that is situated on a slab or footings used for the primary purpose of additional storage space.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Appendix A Zoning, Article III General Provisions Section 3.20 Sheds, storage buildings, and temporary storage containers in residential areas is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3.20 Sheds, storage buildings, and temporary storage containers in residential areas.

(a) Sheds and storage buildings.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing text; Words in underscored type are additions.

- (1) Five-foot Twenty-four (24) inch side and rear setbacks. Structures shall not be permitted in any front or street side yard.
- (2) All residential plots shall be limited to one (1) shed and/or storage building not to exceed a maximum size of Maximum size, one hundred forty-four (144) square feet.
- (3) Not to exceed eight and one-half $(8^{1/2})$ feet in height, except in RVRP districts. Structures shall be limited to one (1) per residential plot.
- (4) All sheds shall require a building permit from the Margate Building Department and shall be subject to the requirements of the most recently adopted version of the Florida Building Code at the time of permitting.
- (b) Temporary storage containers. The following regulations are applicable to temporary storage containers:
- (1) Shall only be permitted in front yards, on a hard surface, permitted by the building department.
- (2) <u>Shall</u> <u>The setback must</u> be <u>setback</u> at least eighteen (18) inches from the side property line and five (5) feet from the front property line.
- (3) May not occupy nor disallow the use of the minimum parking requirements for residential area.
- (4) In order to receive be granted a permit, a removal plan with the name, address, and phone number of an individual who will remove the temporary storage container must be supplied to the Margate Building Department building department. Supplied also must be an An agreement with a trucking company or a company of other means of removal must also be provided.
- (5) The temporary storage container must be removed within seventy-two (72) hours of BCEOC having declared the threat of landfall of a hurricane or immediately upon the issuance of a flood warning notification.
