AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPENDIX A ZONING, ARTICLE III GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 3.20 SHEDS, STORAGE BUILDINGS, AND TEMPORARY STORAGE STRUCTURES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS; PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY STORAGE CONTAINERS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Appendix A Zoning, Article III General provisions, Section 3.20 Sheds, storage buildings, and temporary storage structures in residential areas is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3.20. Sheds, storage buildings, and temporary storage containers in residential areas.

(b) *Temporary storage containers.* The following regulations are applicable to temporary storage containers:

- (1) Shall only be permitted in front yards, on a ~~hard surface~~ paved driveway, permitted by the Margate Building Department.
- (2) Shall not be placed on any portion of any street, sidewalk, or swale ~~be setback at least eighteen (18) inches from the side property line and five (5) feet from the front property line.~~

- 1 (3) ~~May not occupy nor disallow the use of the~~
2 ~~minimum parking requirements for residential area.~~
3 Single family detached dwellings, duplex
4 dwellings, villas, and townhouses shall be limited
5 to a maximum of one (1) temporary storage
6 container at a given residence at any time.

8 (4) In order to receive a permit, residents who live
9 within a homeowner's association or condo
10 association must submit written approval of the
11 portable storage container from their association
12 ~~a removal plan with the name, address, and phone~~
13 ~~number of an individual who will remove the~~
14 ~~temporary storage container must be supplied to~~
15 ~~the Margate Building Department. An agreement with~~
16 ~~a trucking company or a company of other means of~~
17 ~~removal must also be provided.~~

19 (5) The temporary storage container must be removed
20 within seventy-two (72) hours of BCEOC having
21 declared the threat of landfall of a hurricane or
22 immediately upon the issuance of a flood warning
23 notification.

25 (6) The temporary storage container is permitted up
26 to twice per year only and shall remain a maximum
27 of fifteen (15) days per application.

30 **SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
31 conflict herewith are, and the same is, here by repealed to
32 the extent of such conflict.

34 **SECTION 3.** If any section, clause or phrase of this
35 ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a
36 court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in
37 no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of
38 this ordinance.

40 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the City Commission
41 that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be

made a part of the City of Margate Code, and that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article" or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
