WHEREAS, The Salvation Army in the United States serves 60 million meals to anyone in need through various programs nationwide including the food pantry in Broward County since 1926; and


WHEREAS, The Salvation Army, its employees, volunteers, the people of Margate and Broward County through their generous support are “**Doing The Most Good**”.
