2) PZ-07-15 – CONSIDERATION OF A REZONING FOR 6101 W ATLANTIC BOULEVARD AND 513 MELALEUCA DRIVE FROM TOC-C CORRIDOR TO CF-1 COMMUNITY FACILITY

Ben Ziskal explained that item to be considered is a rezoning from TOC-C Corridor to CF-1 Community Facilities property that allows hospitals, churches, etc. The item was heard at the April 14 Development Review Committee (DRC) meeting, and at that time, staff requested a detailed business plan that would indicate the impact the rezoning would have on the property and the adjacent properties. An abbreviated version of the business plan was received today and staff felt that it did not contain sufficient information for the board to make an informed decision; therefore staff is recommending that the item is tabled to next month. The petitioner was contacted and made aware of this recommendation.

Mr. Ziskal explained that if a tabling motion is made and seconded there would be no opportunity for discussion. However, he recommended that no discussion take place at tonight's meeting.
