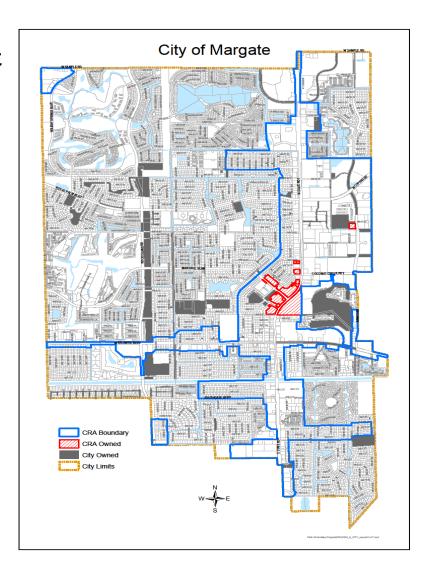

### Margate CRA: Overview

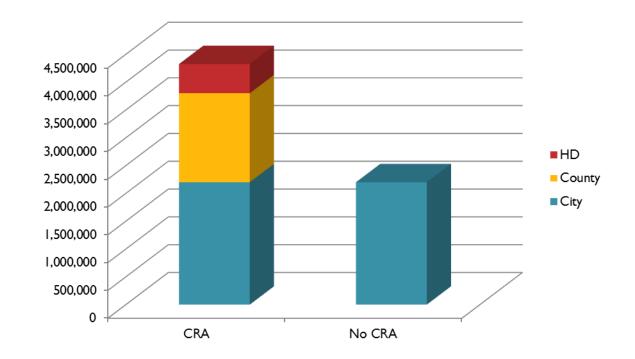
- MCRA formed in 1996, will sunset in 2026

### **New City Positions**

The proposed budget includes the creation of two new City positions that will be funded 75% by the CRA. Total CRA contribution for FY 16: **\$117,055.00** 

**Business Development Coordinator** – 25% to be funded by City. Will be housed in Economic Development Department; will work on business development, economic development initiatives

**Accountant** – 25% to be funded by Senior Center. Will be housed in Finance Department; assigned to CRA and Senior Center finances

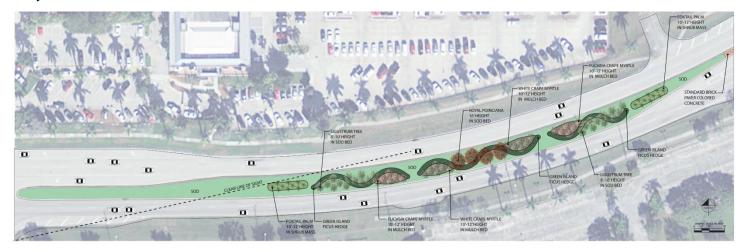

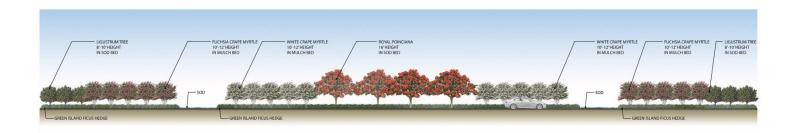

Winfield Boulevard—between State Road 7 and NW 64<sup>th</sup> Terrace Median landscaping, entrance signage and street trees where suitable \$40,000 (design)

**Sports Complex** - Banks Road

Design plan for vacant parcel (per outcome of Parks, Recreation and Open

Space Master Plan) **\$250,000** (design)

#### **Community Center / David Park**

The CRA Plan calls for enhancements to be made to the park which may include improvements to the park facilities, parking lot and community center building facade as well as ADA upgrades.

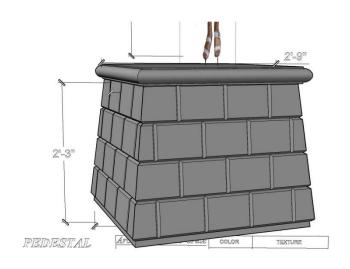

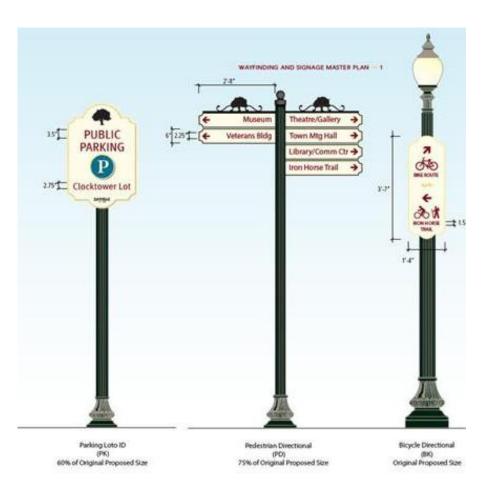
