3	PERTAINING TO REGULATION OF VEHICLE TOWING AND IMMOBILIZATION, AMENDING CHAPTER 27 OF THE		
4	BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"); REPEALING SECTIONS		
5	27-150 AND 27-151 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE; ADOPTING NEW TOWING AND IMMOBILIZATION RATES;		
6	AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE		
7	DATE.		
8	WHEREAS, on October 14, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners repealed		
9	Sections 20-176.12 through 20-176.35 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances and		
10	enacted new towing and immobilization regulations that will go into effect on		
11	April 1, 2015; and		
12	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida		
13	("Board"), desires to repeal Sections 27-150 and 27-151 of the Broward County		
14	Administrative Code ("Administrative Code"), and replace those sections with new		
15	towing and immobilization rates, NOW, THEREFORE,

17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF		
18	BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

20	Section 1. Sections 27-150 and 27-151 of the Administrative Code are hereby		
21	repealed in their entirety.		
22	Section 2. Section 27-150 of the Administrative Code is hereby created to		
23	read as follows:

9		the storage facility, the person retrieving the vehicle may not be charged a
10		Storage Fee.
11	(2)	An Administrative Fee may not be charged if the vehicle owner is
12		identified within twenty-four (24) hours of the vehicle arriving at the
13		storage facility.
14	(3)	The person retrieving the vehicle may pay a \$5 voluntary fee to expedite
15		vehicle ownership verification.
16	(4)	The rates for Other Tows do not apply to tows conducted on behalf of a
17		government agency pursuant to a contract between the government
18		agency and a licensed tow company if such contract provides a different
19		rate structure.
20	(5)	Research Fees may be charged only when the tow company providing the
21		service must actually perform research to determine ownership of a
22		vehicle to notify the vehicle owner, lien-holders, and insurance companies.
23		Written documentation of the efforts undertaken to ascertain ownership of
24		the vehicle must be made available for inspection by the County upon

request. Costs shall mean actual fees charged by the State of Florida for obtaining ownership information and shall include the cost of actual postage fees, advertising fees (if more than a single vehicle is advertised in the same advertisement, then the cost of the advertisement shall be prorated per vehicle), and title search for out-of-state vehicles. Proof of all costs incurred by the tow company must be made available for inspection by the County upon request.

- 8 (6) Effective October 1, 2015, and each October 1 through October 1, 2019, 9 all fees referenced in this Section 27-150 shall be increased by the annual 10 percentage change in the Consumer Price Index ("CPI") or three percent (3%), whichever is less. Each year's fee increase shall be calculated 11 12 based on the fee amount from the previous year. The CPI utilized shall be 13 the most recent CPI reported by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, 14 Southeastern Regional Office (1982-84=100), urban wage earners and 15 clerical workers, for all items not seasonally adjusted as published in January. The adjusted fees shall be calculated by the Broward County 16 Environmental Licensing and Building Permitting Division and shall be 17 18 posted on its website. After October 1, 2019, but before October 1, 2020, 19 the Board of County Commissioners must consider future CPI increases 20 to the rates provided for herein.
