AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 21. MARGATE MINIBUSES; SECTION 1. FEES ESTABLISHED; PROVIDING FOR THE ELIMINATION OF FARES FOR THE MARGATE INNER-CITY MINIBUS SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2013, the City Commission approved a reduction of Margate Inner City Transit Fares from seventy-five cents (\$0.75) to fifty cents (\$0.50) in order to increase ridership to meet the required 7.1 riders per hour needed to receive a \$15.00 per hour subsidy from Broward County; and

WHEREAS, ridership numbers have fallen below the required 7.1 riders per hour needed to receive the \$15.00 per hour subsidy from Broward County; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Margate wishes to eliminate the fares for the Margate Inner City Transit System in order to increase ridership.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> That the foregoing Preamble is hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct by the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida.

SECTION 2: The Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Chapter 21-Inner-City Minibuses, Section 1. - Fees established., is hereby amended to read as follows:

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing text; Words in underscored type are additions.

Sec. 21-1. - Fees established.

There shall be a <u>no</u> charge of fifty cents (\$0.50) for each individual passenger who enters on the City of Margate innercity minibus system.

The fifty-cent fee shall be charged to each passenger who travels on a minibus. The above fee shall be charged upon each separate entry on a minibus.

<u>SECTION</u> 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the City of Margate Code, and that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article" or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

<u>SECTION</u> 6: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
