

SECTION 1: The City Manager may authorize purchases ~~and~~, bid awards, contracts, and contracts for bid awards for projects, supplies, materials or equipment on behalf of the City when individual expenditures do not exceed \$50,000.

SECTION 2: All contracts for projects, supplies, materials or equipment that exceed \$50,000 must be approved by the City Commission.

SECTION 3: The \$50,000 limitation and authorization/approval requirements in Sections 1 and 2 shall not apply to purchases made in accordance with City Code Section 2-25(b)- Nonapplicability to cooperative bidding with other governmental agencies.

SECTION ~~34~~: For individual expenditures for projects, supplies, materials or equipment above \$25,000 and not exceeding \$50,000, notification of said expenditures shall be made to the City Commission.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall apply retroactively to December 17, 2014.

SECTION ~~46~~: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION ~~57~~: If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION ~~68~~: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
