SECTION 1: The City Manager may authorize purchases and, bid awards, contracts, and contracts for bid awards for projects, supplies, materials or equipment on behalf of the City when individual expenditures do not exceed \$50,000.

SECTION 2: All contracts <u>for projects, supplies, materials or equipment</u> that exceed \$50,000 must be approved by the City Commission.

SECTION 3: The \$50,000 limitation and authorization/approval requirements in Sections 1 and 2 shall not apply to purchases made in accordance with City Code Section 2-25(b)-Nonapplicability to cooperative bidding with other governmental agencies.

SECTION <u>34</u>: For <u>individual</u> expenditures <u>for projects</u>, <u>supplies</u>, <u>materials or equipment</u> above \$25,000 and not exceeding \$50,000, notification of said expenditures shall be made to the City Commission.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall apply retroactively to December 17, 2014.

SECTION 46: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION <u>57</u>: If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION <u>68</u>: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
