ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION OF PURCHASES, BID AWARDS, AND CONTRACTS BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF CONTRACTS BY THE CITY COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR NONAPPLICABILITY TO COOPERATIVE BIDDING; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR RETROACTIVE APPLICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 4.10 Contracts and 4.11 Purchases and bid awards of the Charter of the City of Margate was amended by referendum and approved by the voters of the City of Margate in the general election of November 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Margate desires to provide for purchases and bid awards that may be approved by the City Manager and contracts that require Commission approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The City Manager may authorize purchases, bid awards, contracts, and contracts for bid awards for projects, supplies, materials or equipment on behalf of the City when individual expenditures do not exceed \$50,000.

SECTION 2: All contracts for projects, supplies, materials or equipment that exceed \$50,000 must be approved by the City Commission.

SECTION 3: The \$50,000 limitation and authorization/approval requirements in Sections 1 and 2 shall not apply to purchases made in accordance with City Code Section 2-25(b) - Nonapplicability to cooperative

3 SECTION 4: For individual expenditures for projects,
4 supplies, materials or equipment above \$25,000 and not
5 exceeding \$50,000, notification of said expenditures shall
6 be made to the City Commission.

8 SECTION 5: This ordinance shall apply retroactively
9 to December 17, 2014.

11 SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
12 conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed to the
13 extent of such conflict.

15 SECTION 7: If any section, sentence, clause, or
16 phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or
17 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then
18 said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the
19 remaining portions of this ordinance.

21 SECTION 8: This ordinance shall become effective
22 immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
