AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION PURCHASES, BID AWARDS, AND CONTRACTS BY THE MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF CONTRACTS BY THE CITY COMMISSION; PROVIDING NONAPPLICABILITY TO FOR COOPERATIVE BIDDING; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR RETROACTIVE APPLICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 4.10 Contracts and 4.11 Purchases and bid awards, of the Charter of the City of Margate was amended by referendum, approved by the voters of the City of Margate, in the general election of November 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Margate desires to provide for purchases and bid awards that may be approved by the City Manager and contracts that require Commission approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF

THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The City Manager may authorize purchases—and, bid awards, contracts, and contracts for bid awards for projects, supplies, materials or equipment on behalf of the City when individual expenditures do not exceed \$50,000.

SECTION 2: All contracts for projects, supplies, materials or equipment that exceed \$50,000 must be approved by the City Commission.

SECTION 3: The \$50,000 limitation and authorization/approval requirements in Sections 1 and 2 shall not apply to purchases made in accordance with City Code Section 2-25(b)-Nonapplicability to cooperative bidding with other governmental agencies.
