## ATTACHMENT "A"- AREA "D" DESCRIPTIONS

## Code Related Residential Lawn Maintenance (48 hour response time)

Size: Approx. 10,890 Sq. Ft. - . 25 acres (Average for each residential property)
Contractor shall trim and properly edge all shrub and flower beds as well as tree rings, curbs, walks, lighting and all other obstacles in the landscape and remove clippings. Paved areas (hard edges) shall be edged every mowing with respect to the turf type adjacent to the edging. Edging of beds and tree rings (soft edging) shall be executed every mowing with respect to the turf type adjacent to the edging. Damage to property or existing vegetation caused by improper trimming or edging shall be repaired or replaced within 48 hours at the contractor's expense. All walks and other paved areas shall be vacuumed, swept or blown off while the mowing, edging or trimming is in process so that the appearance suffers for the least amount of time. Landscape areas shall be raked and cleaned of clippings, leaves, sticks, twigs and all litter each time the soft edging is done. The above services are all considered part of standard lot cutting and shall be included as part of the contractor's per lot cut fee, which shall be based on the estimated average residential property description provided herein. The City's representative shall approve mowing schedules.

The additional services described in this paragraph shall be required only if specified on the work order. The pruning or trimming of hedges, shrubs or groupings of shrubs must be performed as necessary to maintain a specific height requirement. Mechanical trimming may only be utilized when the mechanical trimmers will not damage the health or appearance of the plant. Groundcover plants shall be selectively cut back to encourage lateral growth and kept in bounds and out of other plantings, walkways, lighting, etc. All areas containing shrubs, ground covers, annuals or bedding plants shall be kept clean and neat in appearance. In addition, contractor shall be responsible for removing vines from planters, on hedges, and on fences. The additional services shall be priced based on a per man hour rate provided by the contractor. City's representative shall review contractor's estimate for the number of man hours required to complete any specific job, and agree to the estimated number of man hours prior to commencement of work for each job requiring man hour priced work.

Contractor shall provide below a single per lot cut fee for lot cutting based on the estimated average residential property description provided herein, and a per man hour rate for all additional maintenance services as specified in paragraph two (2).

[^0]Landscape Service Professionals, Inc. Schedule of Maintenance Tasks Definitions

## A) Herbicide/Weed Eradication:

Weed control will be accomplished, weather permitting, by means of a Glysophate product (i.e. Roundup). A non-selective herbicide will be dispersed in a 2.5 gallon back-pack type sprayer. All applicators will be a trained, Pesticide ID card holder in accordance with the law. Weeds present in ground covers (i.e. Juniper, Liriope) will be mechanically removed by means of a scuffled hoe or by hand. Weeds will be bagged and removed from the property. Applicator will use PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) at all times. Large weeds will be string trimmed, then treated with herbicide.

## B) Debris Removal:

During each service debris will be removed from all areas to be mowed that day. Paper, cans, bottles, etc. will be removed from planting beds, as well as gutters and around medians. Broken branches and palm fronds will be removed, bagged and taken away from the property. All clippings from pruning will be neatly raked and disposed of on the same day of the service.

## C) Mowing:

On commencement of a mowing cycle, a determination will be made as to the size of the mower required for the area. Large turf will areas will be mowed using a rider type mower with $60-72$ " cutting width. Smaller turf areas, such as medians and parking islands, will require a walk behind type mower, varying from $48^{\prime \prime}, 36^{\prime \prime}$ and, in small areas, a $21^{\prime \prime}$ mowers. All crews have access to the requisite mowers for each property. Turf areas near fronts of buildings and heavy traffic areas will be mowed first whenever possible as to give safe passage to visitors and pedestrians whenever possible. Care will be taken to change mowing patterns to keep from creating ruts. Mowers have safety guards on the discharge shoots and are inspected on a regular basis. Mower blades will be kept sharpened and care will be taken to remove no more than $1 / 3$ of the leaf blade on each service.

## D) Hard Edging:

The use of "Stick type" edgers is our preference for edging all hard surfaces. Edging will be performed with each mowing cycle and the clippings as well as dirt will be blown from the edged areas. Irrigation boxes, water meters and other structures will be edged as well. New blades are readily available to crews as to keep edges crisp in appearance.

## E) Soft Edging:

The use of a String trimmer will be used in cases of soft edging. Operators will not bevel edges on planting beds, curbs or tree rings. (This practice causes weakness and unsightliness to the turf areas.) String trimmers will be used only to trim where mowers cannot reach. Operators will blend these areas together with the mowed areas at the mowed height.

## F) Lifting Trees:

The use of loppers, hand pruners, pole saws and power pruners will be used to accomplish lifting of trees. An $8^{\prime}$ clearance shall be maintained. Neat clean cuts will be made with sharp tools. All sucker growth will be removed. Removing branches from below the crown of the trees will allow safe passage for pedestrians, vehicles and ensure a better line of sight. Broken branches will also be addressed during this pruning, as needed. All branches will be neatly stacked away from sidewalks and removed from site at the end of the service. LSP will report any unsafe conditions or damage that might have occurred to a tree, such as an automobile accident, lightning and storm damage etc.

## G) Tree Pruning:

On approved and scheduled pruning cycles, trained personnel will be dispatched to the site. All pruning will be supervised by our on staff ISA certified Arborist. All trees will have suckers and broken branches addressed. Trees will be inspected for damage. Trees will be pruned to keep their natural growing habits and will not be shaped or sheared. Specimen Ligustrum trees shall be shaped using loppers and a mechanical pole saw. Branching that shoots away from the general shape of the tree will be pruned back to the closest lateral branch. Palm pruning will be performed in accordance with ISA standards and Broward County tree trimming codes. No spikes will be allowed on palms. Only seed pods and dead or broken fronds will be trimmed.

## H) Pruning and Shearing:

LSP trim crews utilize both $40^{\prime \prime}$ hedge trimmers with leaf trays as well as $22^{\prime}$ extended trimmers. These trimmers are sharpened on a regular basis to assure clean even cuts. Our trim crews are trained to prune hedges to their natural growth habit. Soft beveled edges are encouraged, promoting lower growth of the hedges. When plant beds are in full bloom as Ixora, crews are instructed to light prune allowing the blooming process to continue. The crews are also trained to be conscience of heights of hedges in medians and entry's where line of sight is critical. Multiple layered beds will be separated, and will have the correct height variations as their growth habit warrants. All clipping and branches will be removed from the hedges and ground and left cleanly raked.

## I) Ornamental Planter Bed Weed Control:

Weed control will be accomplished when possible by means of a Glysophate product (i.e. Roundup). A non-selective herbicide will be dispersed in a 2.5 gallon back-pack type sprayer. The applicator will be a trained, Pesticide ID card holder in accordance with the law. Any beds sensitive to herbicides will be weeded mechanically with scuffle hoe or by hand.

## J) Mulching for Planting Areas and Tree Wells:

When the approved mulch (enhanced decorative colored, shredded hardwood ) is applied by hand or blown in by truck, care will be taken not to have mulch in the crown of plants or on trunks of trees. The approved mulch will be installed at a minimum of 2 " in depth. If the property representative chooses red colored mulch, care will be taken not to schedule during a rain event to avoid staining of sidewalks. All areas will be cleaned during the mulching process with blower type equipment.

## K) Fertilizer/Pesticide/Insecticide/Application:

A) When fertilization has been approved and scheduled, a specialized crew will be dispatched. Fertilizer will be applied with Lesco walk behind spreaders as well as a Lesco Commander motorized spreader at the rates as stated on the label. The applicators will have Pest Operator cards in accordance with the law. When fertilizing trees and palms, the correct amount will be scattered around the drip line and not lumped on the root ball of a tree. Care will be taken to blow off foliage and sidewalks as soon as possible.
B) Pesticides as well as Insecticides will only be applied by Pest card holders under the Supervision of the on staff Certified Pest Operators. A vehicle specifically designed for the use of pest control is part of our fleet and will be used during this process. After a pest or insect is identified, the latest, labeled product will be used. Fire ant control is applied on an as needed basis and is kept with all crews as to be applied during routine mowing and pruning cycles

## L) Irrigation Maintenance:

On a scheduled Irrigation "wet check" our Techs usually work in teams of two. This makes for a more efficient wet check. A routine check consists on turning zones on and making sure proper coverage, pressure and height of head is being achieved. The heads will also be checked for blockage and grass intrusion around the head. Technicians will report any signs of breaks, power outages to controllers, and mainline breaks in a timely fashion to the proper site manager. Any damage from our maintenance teams will be repaired in a timely fashion with same quality parts.
