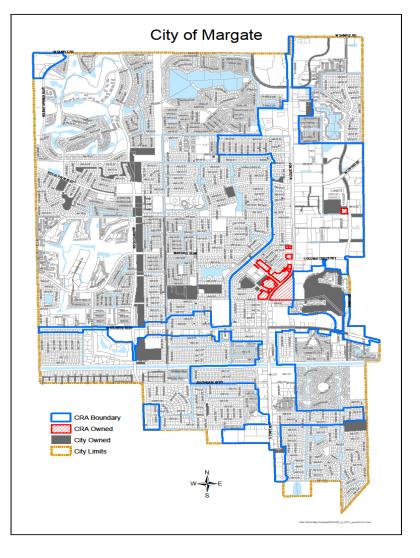

Estimated Tax Increment Revenues FY 2017

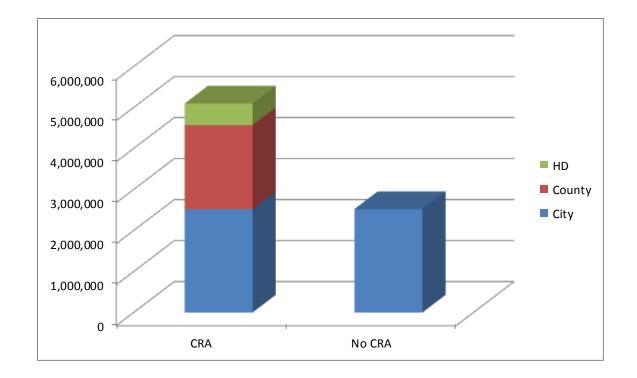

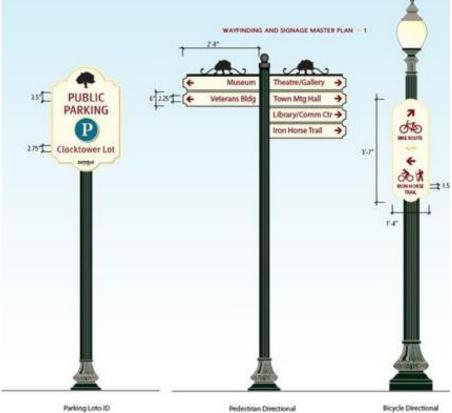
