A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FUNDING OF THE NATIONAL NIGHT OUT EVENT THAT WAS HELD ON AUGUST 2, 2016, TO PROMOTE COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN CRIME PREVENTION AND NEIGHBORHOOD SPIRIT AND POLICE-COMMUNITY RELATIONS, AND TO ENCOURAGE NEIGHBORHOOD CAMARADERIE AS PART OF THE FIGHT FOR SAFER STREETS, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$13,000.00; PROVIDING FOR FUNDING FROM THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1:** That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida approves the funding of the National Night Out event that was held on August 2, 2016, to promote community involvement in crime prevention and neighborhood spirit and police-community relations, and to encourage neighborhood camaraderie as part of the fight for safer streets, at a cost not to exceed \$13,000.00.

**SECTION 2:** That the acquisition is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

**SECTION 3:** The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$13,000 in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETfs") for the 2016 National Night Out event.

**SECTION 4:** The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$13,000 in LETfs for the 2016 National Night Out event complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

**SECTION 5:** The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$13,000 in LETfs for the 2016 National Night Out event complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds are not being used as a

normal source of revenue for the Police Department.

**SECTION 6:** The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$13,000 in LETFs for the 2016 National Night Out event, complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds were not considered in the adoption and approval of the Police Department budget.

**SECTION 7:** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
