AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 37 AMENDING TAXATION; ARTICLE ELECTRICITY, GAS, WATER AND TELEPHONE; SECTION 37-23 EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR EDUCATIONAL AND PROVIDING RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS; FOR FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING PROVIDING CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Margate, Florida, Chapter 37 Taxation, Article II - Electricity, Gas, Water, and Telephone, Section 37-23 - Exemptions, shall be amended to read as follows 1: Sec. 37-23. - Exemptions.

- (a) Definitions. The following definitions shall apply to this article:
 - 1. "Exclusive use" of property means use of property solely for exempt purposes. Such purposes may include more than one type of exempt use.
 - 2. "Predominant use" of property means use of property for exempt purposes in excess of 50 percent but less than exclusive.

1	3. "Educational institution" shall be as defined in
2	Section 196.012, Florida Statutes.
3	4. "Religious institution" shall be as defined in
4	Section 205.022, Florida Statutes.
5	(b) The United States of America, State of Florida, County
6	of Broward, City of Margate, and agencies, boards,
7	commissions and authorities thereof, are exempted from
8	payment of the tax imposed and levied by this article.
9	Said tax shall not apply to sale of bottled water.
10	
11	(c) Property that has an exclusive or predominate use by an
12	educational institution or religious institution is
13	exempted from payment of the tax imposed and levied by
14	this article. Said tax shall not apply to the sale of
15	bottled water.
16 17	SECTION 2 : All ordinances or parts of ordinances
18	in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed
19	to the extent of such conflict.
20	SECTION 3 : If any section, sentence, clause, or
21	phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or
22	unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
23	then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of
24	the remaining portions of this ordinance.
25	SECTION 4: It is the intention of the City
26	Commission that the provisions of this ordinance shall $oldsymbol{2}$

1	become and be made a part of the City of Margate Code, and
2	that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or
3	relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to
4	"section", "article" or such other appropriate word or
5	phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.
6	SECTION 5 : This ordinance shall become effective
7	immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
