RESOLUTION NO. 1027

WHEREAS, a number of churches and schools are now situated within the limits of the Town of Margate, and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that there will be additional churches and schools erected within the Town in the future, and

WHEREAS, a question has come up regarding the matter of exempting churches and schools within the Town from the payment of the utility tax assessed upon the current bills for electricity, gas, water and sewer, and telephone services within the Town,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Margate, that all churches and schools within the Town of Margate shall be exempt from the payment of the said utility taxes, and

BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER, that this exemption from the payment of said utility taxes shall be extended to such institutions only when such institutions conduct their affairs in a building or buildings specifically designated and designed for their purposes, and

EE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the aforesaid exemption shall be extended to said churches and schools only if said churches and schools are non-profit institutions.
