WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Miramar hereby recommits itself to building an atmosphere in which each person's opinion is respected and public and political discourse are aimed at confronting the problems facing our community and not at those with whom we may disagree.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Commission recommits itself to maintaining civility in our public and political discourse and hereby pledges our commitment to the following principles:

- We will respect the right of all citizens in our community to hold different opinions;
- We will avoid rhetoric intended to humiliate, illegitimize or question the wisdom of those whose opinions are different from ours;
 - We will strive to understand differing perspectives;
 - We will choose our words carefully;
- We will speak truthfully without accusation and we will avoid distortion;

 and
- We will speak out against violence, prejudice and incivility in all of their forms, whenever and wherever they occur.
