12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, the City Commission has noted the rapid increase in the development and approval of self-storage uses within the City of Margate; and
16 17 18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, the City requires time to analyze, review, consider, modify, process for adoption and implement potential changes to its Code of Ordinances pertaining to the impact of self-storage uses and similar type uses within the City of Margate; and
22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City's residents.
26 27 28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:
29	SECTION 1 : That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are
30	ratified and confirmed and are made a part of this Resolution.
31	SECTION 2 : That it is deemed to be in the best
32	interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and
33	citizens of the City of Margate that a six month moratorium be
34	imposed on all real property within the City of Margate
35	pertaining to the approval of any new self-storage uses, or
36	similar type uses as described above, including issuance of

Local Business Tax Receipts, Certificates of Occupancy, or any
other development approval.

3	SECTION 3 : All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
4	conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
5	SECTION 4 : If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase
6	of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a
7	court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no
8	way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
9	Ordinance.
10	SECTION 5 : This Ordinance shall become effective
11	immediately upon adoption at its second reading.
