RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ACQUISITION OF IAPRO PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS SOFTWARE AND BLUE TEAM FIELD SUPPORT SERVICES SOFTWARE, FROM IAPRO AS A SOLE SOURCE DISTRIBUTOR AND PROVIDER, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$11,500.00; PROVIDING FOR FUNDING FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1**: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida approves the acquisition of IAPRO Software and Blue Team Field Support Services Software from IAPRO as sole source distributor and provider, utilizing funds from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund, in an amount not to exceed \$11,500.

**SECTION 2**: That the acquisition is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

**SECTION 3**: The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$11,500 in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") to acquire the software from IAPRO.

**SECTION 4**: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$11,500 in LETFs to acquire the software from IAPRO complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

**SECTION 5**: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$11,500 in LETFs to acquire the software from IAPRO complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds are not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Police Department.

**SECTION 6**: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$11,500 in LETFs to acquire the software from IAPRO complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds were not considered in the adoption and approval of the Police Department budget.

**SECTION 7:** That the Mayor and City Manager are authorized and directed to execute a contract for the above acquisition, or administration is authorized to issue a purchase order for same.

**SECTION 8:** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
