RESOLUTION OF THECITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ACQUISITION VIGILANT SOLUTIONS LEARN LICENSE RECOGNITION (LPR) SOFTWARE, FROM SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER VETTED SECURITY SOLUTIONS, AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$11,000.00; PROVIDING FOR FUNDING FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida, approves the acquisition of Vigilant Solutions Learn License Plate Recognition (LPR) Software from sole source provider Vetted Security Solutions, utilizing funds from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund, in an amount not to exceed \$11,000.

SECTION 2: That the acquisition of the LPR Software is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$11,000 in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") to acquire the software from Vetted Security Solutions.

SECTION 4: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$11,000 in LETFs to acquire the software from Vetted Security Solutions complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$11,000 in LETFs to acquire the software from Vetted Security Solutions complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds are not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Police Department.

SECTION 6: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$11,000 in LETFs to acquire the software from Vetted Security Solutions complies with Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, in that the funds were not considered in the adoption and approval of the Police Department budget.
