The following Bid Item Notes apply to the bid items:

1. Bid Item 2 is a lump sum pay item for a Maintenance of Traffic and includes all pedestrian access maintenance. All crosswalks and sidewalks shall remain open and free of obstructions. Temporary painting for roadways and crosswalks shall be maintained throughout the project. Costs shall include the use of flagmen if needed.

2. Bid Items 4 and 5 include all costs associated with installing concrete glass aggregate as shown on the plans or as determined in the field by the City. The costs include installation of concrete glass aggregate, all associated excavation, management of excavated materials, new limerock and sub base as needed, backfill, compaction, and testing.
3. Bid Item 6 includes all costs associated with removing any existing trees impacted by the proposed improvements.
4. Bid Item 7 includes all costs associated with relocating any existing trees impacted by the proposed improvements.
5. Bid Item 8 includes all costs associated with the removal of the existing concrete as shown on the plans or as determined in the field by the City.
6. Bid Item 9 is a lump sum pay item that includes the complete restoration of the site impacted by any construction activity associated with the concrete sidewalk improvements. Any site areas impacted by the contractor outside of proposed concrete work such as asphalt overlay, pavement markings, etc. will be restored by the contractor at no additional cost to the City. The pay item includes but is not limited to restoration of new sod, landscaping, trees, new fill, irrigation, driveway aprons, mail boxes, fences, pipes, curbing, sidewalk, etc. to an equal or better condition prior to construction. The contractor shall include the costs associated with a preconstruction video and pictures to confirm existing conditions if needed. Any damage not confirmed by preconstruction video or pictures will be repaired at no additional cost to the City.
7. Bid Item 27 is a lump sum pay item that will include all costs associated with directional drill requirements, pipe sleeves, etc. as shown on the plans or as determined in the field by the City.
8. Permit Fees – cost should include all permits, coordination of inspections, and close-out of any/all permits with the City and County upon completion.
