ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE V - GREEN BUILDING POLICY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

Section 1: Ariticle V - Green Building Policy, Sec. 31-51. - General, Section 31-51., is amended to read as follows 1 :

Section 31-51. - General.

(a) Definitions. The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this chapter [article], shall have the meaning ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning.

GBI means the Green Building Initiative.

Green building means generally the resource-efficient design, construction, and operation of buildings deemed it to be by employing environmentally sensible construction practices, systems and materials.

Green Globes means the current version of the green building rating system administered by GBI.

LEED means the <u>current version of the USGBC's</u> leadership in energy and environmental design rating system, <u>version 2.0</u>, of the <u>United Stated Green Building Council</u>, any amendments thereto or subsequent <u>versions</u> in effect at the time a project is registered with the USGBC.

(b)

LEED certified means a project that has attained a minimum of twenty-six (26) points as determined by USCBC's rating system.

LEED gold means a project that has attained a minimum of thirty-nine (39) points as determined by USGBC's rating system.

LEED platinum means a project that has attained a minimum of fifty-two (52) points as determined by USGBC's rating system.

LEED silver means a project that has attained a minimum of thirty-three (33) points as determined by USGBC's rating system.

Project means construction associated with the creation, development, major renovation, or erection of any building deemed to be eligible for thean approved green building certification program.

USGBC means the United States Green Building Council.

Purpose. The purpose of the eCity's green building policy is to provide the eCity with a certified-based green building program. This program will provide sustainable and environmentally friendly practices of construction and design. It shall be the policy of the eCity to achieve at least the minimum LEED rating of "LEED certified" certification level of the USGBC LEED, GBI Green Globes green building certification programs or other equivalent certification program determined by the City for all new eCity-owned and building construction. All operated renovation projects to eCity-owned and -operated buildings including major renovation involving elements of HVAC renovation, significant envelope modifications major interior rehabilitation, which meets the USGBC or GBI definition for major renovation, shall be brought up to "LEED certified" status. In order ensure that \underline{eC} ity construction projects meet the green building standards, all eCity construction projects deemed to be eligible for the program shall be registered with the USGBCappropriate green building program and the project team, including, but not limited to, the architect, engineer, general contractor, and eCity agencies responsible for the projects, shall seek certification of registered

projects. Design submittals for all such projects shall be reviewed and marked as "credit anticipated" by CBC prior to the submission of a petition to the development review committee.

Section 2: Ariticle V - Green Building Policy, Sec. 31-52. - Environmental Categories, Section 31-52., is amended to read as follows:

Section 31-52 - Environmental Categories Reserved.

The six (6) environmental categories for LEED's building evaluation and rating are:

- (1) Sustainable site characteristics;
- (2) Water use efficiency;
- (3) Energy use and atmosphere;
- (4) Materials and resource usage;
- (5) Indoor environmental quality; and
- (6) Innovation in sustainable design strategies.

Section 3: Ariticle V - Green Building Policy, Sec. 31-53. - LEED rating policy, Section 31-53., is amended to read as follows:

Section 31-53. - LEEDGreen building rating policy.

The LEED's and Green Globes rating systems is are a certification tools. The USGBC points Points shall be awarded to building projects that incorporate the design and construction practices and technologies listed in LEED the appropriate rating system. The project shall be subject to certification by a qualified eCity staff member or third party who has been trained and certified as a LEED accredited professional (LEED AP) or Green Globes Professional (GGP). For purposes of the program, "third party" means any person or entity authorized by USGBC or GBI to verify that a project has satisfied any or all of the requirements associated with LEED or GBI standard designated for a particular project.

SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
