SUBJECT: HyperFire License Plate Camera & Cable Box/Security Enclosure Purchase

In August 2017, The Special Operations Unit acquired two Reconyx SM750 HyperFire License Plate Cameras, along with two Hyperfire Cable Boxes. These two license plate cameras were strategically deployed in two "hot spot" locations in our city. Within the first week of deployment there were several vehicle burglaries in the area of one of the camera's locations. When reviewing the camera's memory card/footage, the Special Enforcement Team was able to obtain critical vehicle/tag information and in turn we were able to positively identify the suspect vehicle that was used to commit several vehicle burglaries. Several arrests were made and the victim's property was recovered all due to this technology.

On a separate date and location of deployment, there was a vehicle burglary which occurred and the victim only was able to observe a white Lexus that parked near her vehicle. When reviewing the camera's memory card/footage, the Special Enforcement Team was able to obtain critical vehicle/tag information and in turn we were able to positively identify the suspect vehicle that was used to commit this vehicle burglary. The Special Enforcement Team was able to create an intelligence flyer and the Coral Springs Police Department was able to identify this vehicle as the same vehicle involved in vehicle burglaries within their City. Again, this outcome would have not been possible without the utilization of the Reconyx SM750 Hyperfire License Plate Cameras.

These camera systems can be utilized by all bureaus of the police department. They can be deployed for our Code Compliance in areas of illegal dumping complaints to identify perpetrators and their vehicles. The Criminal Investigations Unit can utilize these cameras in areas frequently targeted by burglary suspects, to identify suspect vehicles and generate intelligence fliers to further investigations. The Special Operations Unit can utilize the camera in areas of increased narcotics traffic, to identify and curtail narcotics purchasers and traffickers in the designated area. The possibilities and options for utilization of these camera systems are endless.

The 2018 Goals and Objectives for the Special Operations Unit include the task of, "Successfully obtain technology innovations to further narcotics investigations." The HyperFire License Plate Cameras and Cable Box/Heavy-Duty Security Enclosures accomplish both the aforementioned goal and objective.

I am respectfully requesting the purchase of four HyperFire License Plate Cameras, two Hyperfire Cable Boxes and three HyperFire Camera Series Heavy-Duty Security Enclosures. This request of four camera systems and boxes is needed for the size of our City, with respects to the numerous "hot spot" locations that would benefit from the deployment of this camera system. With this potential purchase, we would then possess a total of six cameras city-wide and this would greatly assist our agency and citizens within the community.

The Special Enforcement Team obtained a price quote from our current vender "Reconyx," which had the lowest price from our original purchase. I have attached the price quote to this memorandum. *No reoccurring costs associated with this purchase or equipment*

Four SM750 HyperFire License Plate Cameras - \$2,469.96 Two Hyperfire Cable Boxes - \$284.98 Three HyperFire Camera Series Heavy-Duty Security Enclosures - \$199,47 Shipping and Handling - 54.64 Total Purchase - \$3,009.05

LT J. Galaska - 1/31/18 - Two of these cameras were purchased last year to try them out. They have proven reliable and very useful for the successful investigation and apprehension of criminals that operate vehicles in our city. One of the above incidents of success, the camera was instrumental in apprehending the subjects who had broken into a city dignitary's vehicle. I feel this is a wise purchase to assist in the successful identification and apprehension of criminals.
