BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida approves the acquisition and waiving of bidding for various critical incident equipment and supplies to increase response effectiveness for active emergency situations, and utilization of funds from the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund in an amount not to exceed \$117,000.

SECTION 2: That the expenditure is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Margate.

SECTION 3: The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure in Federal Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") for the various critical incident equipment and supplies for the Police Department.

SECTION 4: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure in LETFs for the various critical incident equipment and supplies for the Police Department, in that the funds will be used for an appropriate law enforcement purpose.

SECTION 5: The Chief of Police certifies that the expenditure in LETFs to for the various critical incident equipment and supplies for the Police Department, in that the funds are not being used as a normal source of revenue for the Police Department.
