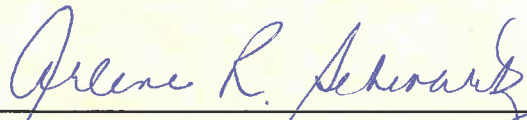
WHEREAS, The City of Margate encourages the awareness effort in order to educate parents, professionals and the general public about autism and its effects.
