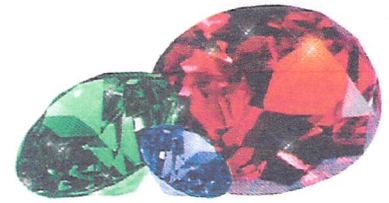

SPECIAL EVENTS FUNDING/DONATION REQUEST PROGRAM INFORMATION GUIDE

Organizations or individuals seeking funding from the City of Margate must complete the Special Events Funding/Donation Request Application for Organizations or the Special Events Funding/Donation Request Application for Individuals. The amount requested cannot exceed \$1,000 per organization or \$500 per individual. Organizations or individuals must submit said application and necessary documentation to:

For requests by both organizations and individuals, the funding request must provide a public benefit (educational, economic, health, etc.) to the City of Margate and its citizens. If the requestor is an individual, the individual must be a City of Margate resident. For individual requests, registration fees associated with a school, program, or event shall be paid directly to the sponsoring entity, if possible. If the requestor is an organization, the organization must:

- Be a non-profit organization, either with Articles of Incorporation filed with the Florida Department of State, or for those non-profits organized within another state, be registered with the State of Florida as a foreign corporation.
- Be in existence and operating within the State of Florida for at least twelve (12) months prior to the date of application to the City for a donation.
- Submit in addition to their application: (1) a copy of their 501(c)3, 501(c)4, or 501(c)6 notification letter; (2) a copy of their current Form 990 (if your organization is required to file this document); (3) a copy of their last completed audit; and (4) annual budget.

After receipt of the application, all applications shall be presented to the City Commission at the next regularly-scheduled City Commission meeting. The City Commission, at its sole discretion, shall determine which organizations or individuals are awarded funding. All decisions of the City Commission are final and binding. Once funding has been approved, the approved amount will be provided to the organization or individual. Please note that an affidavit will be prepared by the City and must be completed by the organization or individual recipient within two weeks of the event/expenditure. In addition, reports of service delivery/expenditures of any funds and/or receipts may be required. Furthermore, all individual recipients are requested to provide/present photographs/details following the event/expenditure at a public meeting. If an organization or individual is awarded a donation for a particular purpose/event, and the event is canceled, a full reimbursement to the City is required. Organizations and individuals may apply for one donation per fiscal year. Organizations or individuals that have failed to meet a reimbursement obligation in previous years or additional conditions of approval will not be eligible for future consideration until all prior obligations have been fulfilled.

Bi-Wi "Because I'm Worth It!" International, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization specializing in mentoring and self-esteem building in girls ages 8 and up. Our mission is to: (1) assist in the building of low self-worth; (2) Assist in empowering participants to make better choices, (3) Administering tools which will assist participants in achieving their destiny in life; (4) ultimately, producing generations of women who: discern their self-worth demand their respect; and are destined to achieve their greatest potential. Bi-Wi is a one of a kind program designed specifically for girls with low self-esteem. The program targets the root of the low self-esteem problem and teaches girls to embrace their uniqueness and love themselves, flaws and all. Since 2014, Bi-Wi has assisted 130 girls, 45 of whom are Margate residents.

The funds provided by Margate will be used towards two ten week educational programs for 30 students at Margate Elementary School, during the academic school year 2018-2019, using the National recognized program developed by Dr. Morris Rosenberg, and Bi-Wi's ten week curriculum. These programs encompass the measurement of self esteem and the role it plays with personal growth. This program is a spring board in which we provide a holistic approach to participants that helps with the development of a positive sense of self worth, resulting in better lifestyle choices and improved negative behavior.

Please provide a needs statement (Why do you need the requested funds?):

Low self esteem is a thinking disorder in which an individual views themselves as inadequate, unlovable, and/or incompetent. Among high school students, 44 percent of girls attempt to lose weight, and 75 percent of girls with low self-esteem reported engaging in negative activities like cutting, bullying, smoking, drinking, or disordered eating. This comes to 25 percent of girls with earthy self-esteem. The requested funds are needed to assist Bi-Wi International, Inc. in accomplishing the goal of educating girls at the Margate Elementary School on how to build low self-esteem. Bi-Wi has administered the 10 week self-esteem building program to fifteen (15) new Margate students struggling with this issue, each year, for the past 3 years. We require community assistance to help inform and educate these girls and assist them in building their low self-esteem so that they will have an equal opportunity in achieving success in life, ultimately, being a positive impact in the Margate community. Your contributions will assist Bi-Wi with these efforts.

Explain the public benefit (educational, economic, health, etc.) to the City of Margate and its citizens from the City funds received:

The main benefit of Bi-Wi "...Because I'm Worth It!" is an educational benefit. Bi-Wi assists in building the foundation for a healthy self-esteem. The Bi-Wi curriculum helps to educate participants on the root causes of negative self-image (poor thinking) and offer tools to help reverse the negative thinking to positive thinking. This positively affects the child's self-image and associated negative behaviors. The benefits of a healthy self-esteem are an asset, both to the child and the public. For example, children with healthy self-esteem (1) value themselves and think of themselves as worthy partners and capable problem solvers, (2) develop a healthy balance of liking who they are, but also recognizing that there are ways they can continue to grow and to develop, (3) feel that they have positive characteristics and skills they can offer to other people (public), (4) they also feel they are worthy of being loved and accepted by others including family and friends, (5) feel fundamentally deserving of their fair share of resources, (6) are more likely to be happy, to make and keep positive friends, and to persevere when working through difficult situations that occur in relationships. This benefits the child and the public.

Please provide an outcome statement (What will be accomplished with the money?) explaining the impact as a result of obtaining funding from the City:

The accomplished goal for these funds is to assist Bi-Wi with the teaching of the specialized curriculum to the needy girls in the Margate Community, (via the Margate Elementary School), demonstrating physical signs of low self-esteem/self-image. These funds will help us teach and improve the way girls view themselves, demonstrate itself by behavioral improvement with these girls, and their helping of others as they share with others their experience and knowledge gained through the Bi-Wi curriculum.

Demonstrate how you will evaluate your results. These measures need to be directly related to the need and expected outcome:

Bi-Wi performs a "Mirror Test" and implements the "Rosenberg Self-Esteem Scale", a 10-item scale that measures global self-worth by measuring both positive and negative feelings about the self, at inception and conclusion of the program. A comparison of both scores measure improvement. The Rosenberg Scale is a proven effective tool for assessing global self-esteem. Psychologists and sociologists and social science researchers commonly use this tool in children adolescents, and adults to measure self-esteem. Both the Mirror test and the Rosenberg Self-Esteem Scale will be administered at the beginning and end of the ten weeks sessions. The beginning scores of each will be compared to each ending score, and an assessment of the child's calculated score is the measured positive or negative improvement.
