RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF APPROVING THEFUNDING OF NATIONAL NIGHT OUT EVENT TO BE HELD ON AUGUST 7, 2018, TO PROMOTE COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN CRIME PREVENTION NEIGHBORHOOD SPIRIT AND POLICE-COMMUNITY RELATIONS, AND TO ENCOURAGE NEIGHBORHOOD CAMARADERIE AS PART OF THE FIGHT FOR SAFER STREETS, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$13,500.00; PROVIDING FOR FUNDING FROM THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (LETF); PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Margate, Florida approves the funding of the National Night Out event to be held on August 7, 2018, to promote community involvement in crime prevention and neighborhood spirit and police-community relations, and to encourage neighborhood camaraderie as part of the fight for safer streets, at a cost not to exceed \$13,500.00.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: The Chief of Police recommends the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$13,500 in State Law Enforcement Trust Funds ("LETFs") for the 2018 National Night Out event.
