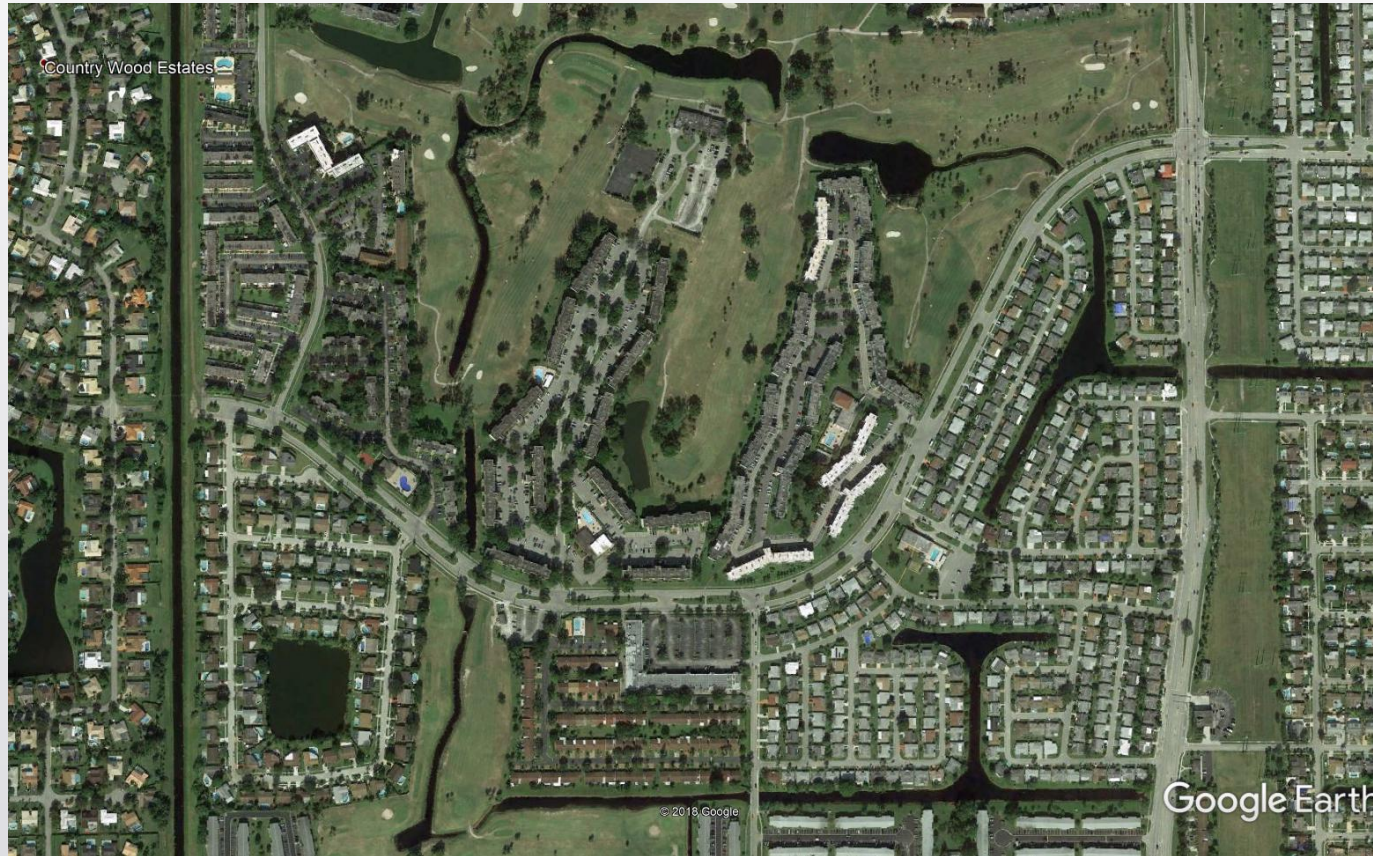
Suburban Complete Street Examples



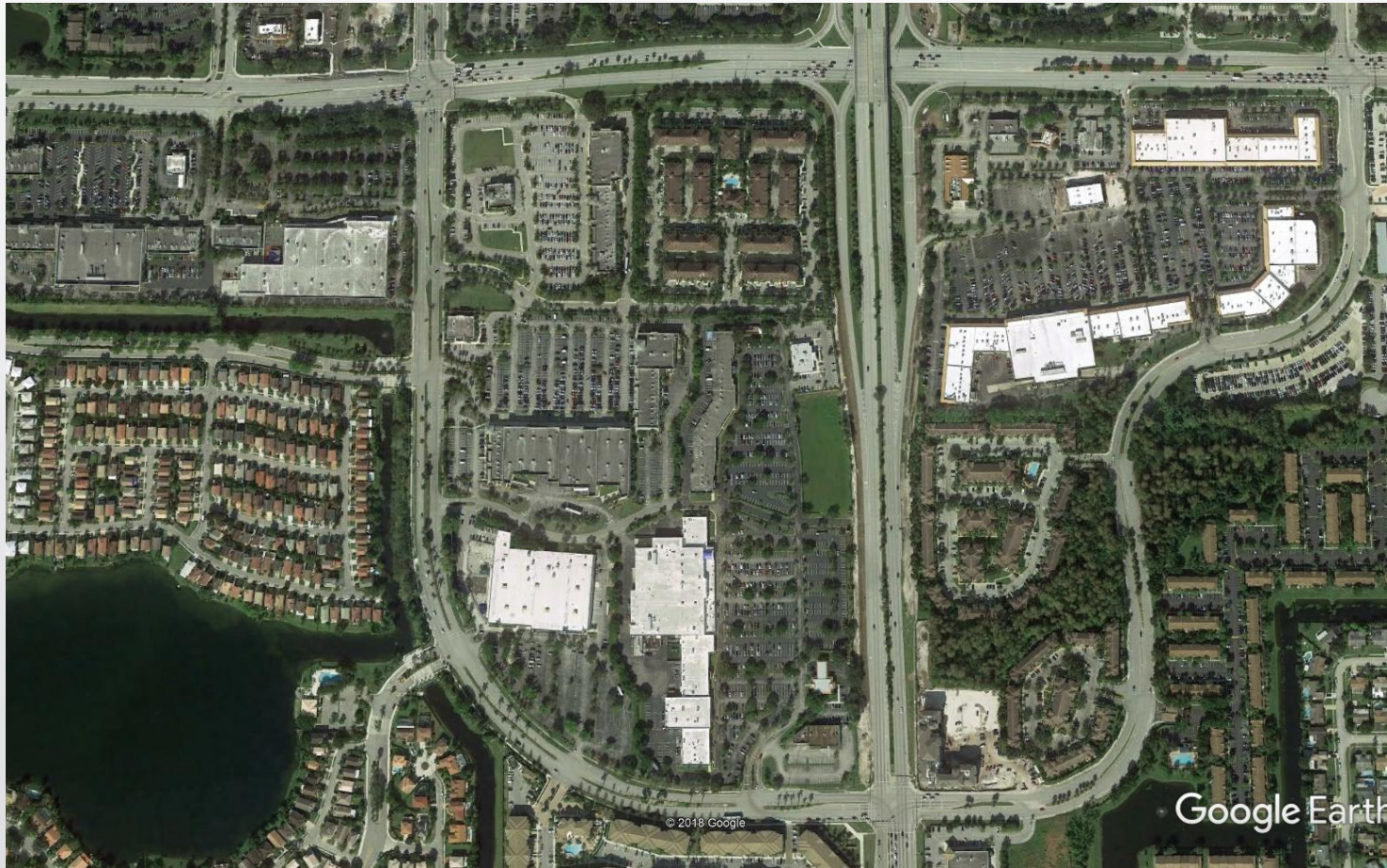

- Create a sense of openness and reduced the feel of density
- Improve connectivity between neighborhoods and with commercial areas
- Create a linear “park” with multiple uses
- Family friendly
- Provide opportunities for safe bikeways, jogging trails, exercise trails, etc.
- Promote a health life-style
- Reduce pavement, thereby reducing runoff and heat island effect
