Ms. Karin Diaz, Project Director of the Northwest Focal Point Senior Center District (NWFPSCD), thanked the Board for approving the contracts and agreements which are to enhance services at the NWFPSC. Upcoming events: The Center will celebrate International Folk Festival Day on October 19th. On this day, the Center celebrates its' diverse community. Seniors come dressed in traditional costumes representing their countries of origin. The Halloween Costume Parade and Magic Show will be on October 31st. On November 1st, there will be a lecture on Estate Planning, Wills and Trusts in collaboration with the Margate Police Department at 11:00 AM. And on November 13th, also in collaboration with the Margate Police Department, there will be a lecture on Phishing for Seniors. The Senior Center car was sent to auction and we received \$510.00. We will be adapting the training and creating two versions, one for our seniors in Adult Day Care and one for our seniors attending the Senior Center.
