Substance of Ordinance

- Increasing eligibility window for grand opening signage from 60 days to 365
- New opportunity for grand opening signage
 - New LBTR for apartment
 - New fictitious name for non-residential

Residential

Current

 Approval of the grand opening signage must be obtained within 60 days of the release of a model home certificate of occupancy.

Proposed

 Approval of the grand opening signs must be obtained from the Department of Development Services within 365 days of the release of a model unit certificate of occupancy or upon issuance of a new local business tax receipt (LBTR) for an apartment complex.

Non-Residential

Current

 Approval of the grand opening signage must be obtained within 60 days of the issuance of the first local business tax receipt for a business at a new location or within 60 days of the transfer of an existing business.

Proposed

 Approval of the grand opening signage must be obtained from the Department of Development Services within 365 days of the issuance of the first local business tax receipt for a business at a new location, the transfer of an existing business, or the registration of a fictitious name with the Division of Corporations of the Florida Department of State.

Staff Recommendation

Approve
