SUBJECT: SRT Ballistic Vests – 5 Year Replacement

The Special Response Team is equipped with upgraded ballistic body armor and ballistic helmets to protect them from the increased threats associated with the duties they are required to perform. This equipment needs to be replaced every five years. By July 2019, Fifteen team members will need their body armor replaced and seventeen team members will need their helmets replaced.

The team has had an opportunity to see product offerings from our current vendors but would prefer the package offered by Prima Vista International, Inc. They currently provide body armor for the BSO and Coral Springs SWAT teams among others. This body armor can be purchased under the City of Coral Springs contract #15-D-064 and would not require going out to bid. Attached you will find a quote detailing current pricing.

It is also vital that the carriers be constructed of strong materials and be available in the multi-cam color which reflects the sun more efficiently and makes the officers less visible.

An RFP (Request for Proposal) was prepared for the purchase of SWAT Body Armor and a total of two proposals were received from the following firms:

- Prima Vista International Inc.
- SRT Supply Inc.

The Evaluation Committee consisting of: Brad Mock, Captain, Glen Dorow, Sergeant, Nick Mazzei, Sergeant, Cody Jacobs, Detective, and Gail Dixon, Purchasing Agent II reviewed the proposals and requested a sample carrier be provided for testing purposes.

Prima Vista provided the carrier as proposed. SRT Supply, who had proposed the same carrier as Prima Vista as well as an alternative carrier, was unable to provide the alternative carrier for testing.

The First Spear Siege-R carrier submitted by Prima Vista met or exceeded all of the specifications in the RFP and after being thoroughly tested by the SWAT team members was found to fulfill the requirements in the RFP.

The Evaluation Committee selected Prima Vista as the top ranked proposer for the following reasons:

- The ballistic carrier package met or exceeded all of the specifications
- Prima Vista was the lowest price proposer for the First Spear Siege-R equipment.
- Prima Vista is a local vendor and will be able to make any needed repairs or replacements quickly and easily
- The First Spear Siege-R carrier utilizes the latest technology which results in a lightweight, comfortable design that is quick and simple for team members to put on and remove in case of emergency or injury.
- The First Spear Siege-R carrier has attachment points constructed of lightweight high performance polymers that exceed the strength of other molded fasteners currently used on operational equipment.

For the reasons stated above, the Evaluation Committee recommends the award of contract to Prima Vista International.
