ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE,
FLORIDA, AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET
(ORDINANCE NUMBERS 2018-5, 2018-8, AND 2019-
5); PROVIDING FOR TRANSFER FROM THE GENERAL
FUND TO THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR
RENOVATION OF CITY FACILITIES FOR THE BUILDING
DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING
FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Margate adopted its Fiscal Year 2019
Budget through Ordinance 2018-5 and amended it through
Ordinances 2018-8, and 2019-5; and

WHEREAS, periodic modifications to the estimated revenues
and expenditures for the fiscal year may be necessary for
fiscal management purposes and to implement decisions of the
City Commission; and

WHEREAS, revisions are currently proposed to the Fiscal
Year 2019 Budget of the General Fund and Capital Projects
Fund for renovation of City facilities for the Building
Department; and

WHEREAS, budget transfers between departments or funds
which increase or decrease a department's budget and all
budget amendments which increase or decrease the total budget
requires Commission approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby
ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and
incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is deemed to be a
public emergency affecting the health, property or the public
peace of the citizens of the City of Margate.

SECTION 3: That fiscal year 2019 budget (Ordinance
numbers 2018-5, 2018-8, and 2019-5) is hereby amended, as
set forth in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto
and specifically made a part of this Ordinance.

2 SECTION 4: That the City Commission hereby directs
3 the Administration to provide for any budget transfers
4 necessary to implement this Ordinance.

6 SECTION 5: That all ordinances or resolutions or
7 parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith be,
8 and the same are, hereby repealed to the extent of such
9 conflict.

11 SECTION 6: That if any section, sentence, clause, or
12 phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or
13 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then
14 said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the
15 remaining portions of this Ordinance.

17 SECTION 7: That this Ordinance shall become
18 effective immediately upon adoption at this reading.
