COMPLETE STREETS MASTER PLAN

- Approved by the Broward MPO Board on February 14, 2019
- Intended to guide future investment in Complete Streets improvements by developing a *prioritized list of projects* based on technical, data-driven analysis, including access to transit.








COMPLETE STREETS MASTER PLAN


- Complete Streets Projects
 - Projects within a Bundle Area
- Super Connectors
 - Projects connecting Bundle Areas/Existing Facilities
- Public Outreach
 - Connected networks
 - Comfort
 - Access to everyday destination





WALKING AUDIT PURPOSE

- Highlight **corridors** and **areas** that could benefit from a street assessment to better promote all modes of transportation.
- Aims to engage stakeholders, community members, technical staff, elected officials and representatives of non-traditional transportation partners, such as the AARP, Health agencies, YMCA.
- Feedback gathered as part of the Walking Audit will inform the Master Plan to take into consideration as the scope is developed.

SOUTHGATE BOULEVARD FROM SW 81ST AVENUE TO SR 7/US 441

 Separated bicycle lanes (W of SW 65th Ave), bicycle lanes (E of SW 65th Ave), bike box (SR 7/US 441), continuous pedestrian zone (sidewalk gaps), and furnishing zone.

Feedback gathered as part of the Walking Audit. Pedestrian Lighting, Pedestrian enhancement treatments, Connection to Existing Trail, High Emphasis Marked Crosswalks, transit shelters and amenities, Curb Radii reduction and bike box at Southgate Boulevard and SR-7/US-441, Provide a green marked bicycle lane east of SW 65th Avenue, Mid-block signed and marked crosswalk at SW 73rd Terrace and SW 63rd Avenue.

























